Mitzvot



Kohanim should NOT enter the Temple with long hair.



The Kohanim must NOT enter the Temple with torn clothes.



Kohanim must NOT enter the Temple in a state of intoxication.



The Kohanim must NOT leave the Mishkan during the sacrificial service.



Do not eat an animal that is not kosher.



DO NOT eat fish that are not kosher.



DO NOT eat birds that are not kosher.



DO NOT eat any crawling creature.



DO NOT eat any crawling creature.



DO NOT eat tiny insects found in grains and fruits.



DO NOT eat unclean creatures that swarm in the water.



DO NOT eat insects that have emerged due to the deterioration or rotting of food or objects.



Examine the animals to discover if they possess the characteristics that make them kosher.



Examine the fish to discover if they possess the characteristics that make them kosher.



Examine the lobsters to discover if they possess the characteristics that make them kosher.



Precept of the animal without slaughtering (nevela).



Beware of impure drinks or foods.



Precept of the impurity (tumah) of the eight crawling creatures (sherets) described by the Torah.

On the eighth day Moses summoned Aaron and his sons, and the elders of Israel. He said to Aaron, "Take a young bull from the herd for a sin offering and a ram for a burnt offering, without blemish, and bring them before the Lord.

And speak to the Israelites and say to them, "Take a male goat for a sin offering, a young bull and a ram without blemish a year old for a burnt offering, an ox and a ram for a peace offering, to sacrifice before the Lord, and a grain offering mixed with oil. For today the Lord will appear to you." So they brought the things Moses had commanded to the front of the Tent of Meeting, and the whole community came and presented themselves before the Lord. Then Moses said to Aaron, "Come near to the altar and offer your sin offering and your burnt offering to make atonement for yourself and for the people; "And sacrifice the people's offering and make atonement for them, as the Lord has commanded." Aaron approached the altar and sacrificed the bull as a sin offering. He then brought the grain offering and, taking a handful of it, burned it in smoke on the altar—in addition to the morning burnt offering. He sacrificed the bull and the ram, the people's comfort offering. Aaron's sons passed him the blood, which he sprinkled against all sides of the altar.

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Aaron lifted up his hands toward the people and blessed them; and he came down after presenting the sin offering, the burnt offering, and the peace offering. Then Moses and Aaron entered the Tent of Meeting. When they came out, they blessed the people; and the Presence of the Lord appeared to all the people. Fire came out from before the Lord and consumed the burnt offering and the fat portions on the altar. And all the people saw it, and they shouted and fell on their faces.

- Now Aaron's sons Nadab and Abihu each brought his censer, put fire in it, and placed incense on it; and they offered unauthorized fire before the Lord, which he had not commanded them. And fire came out from the Lord and consumed them; so they died at the Lord's command. Then Moses said to Aaron, "This is what the Lord meant when he said: 'Among those who approach me I am holy, and I am glorified before all the people.'" And Aaron remained silent.





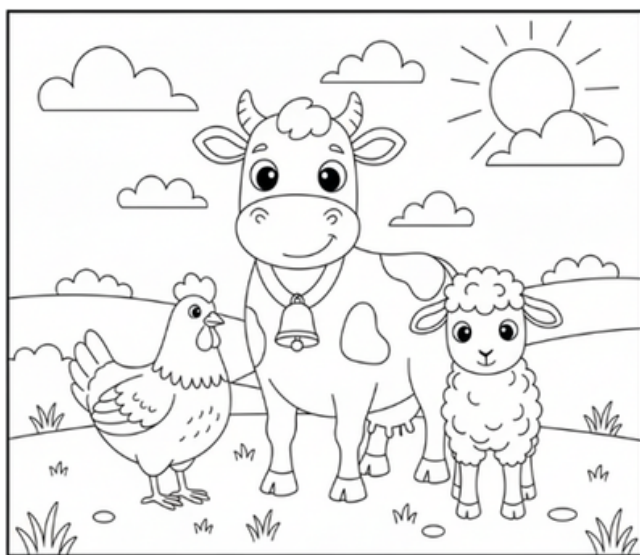
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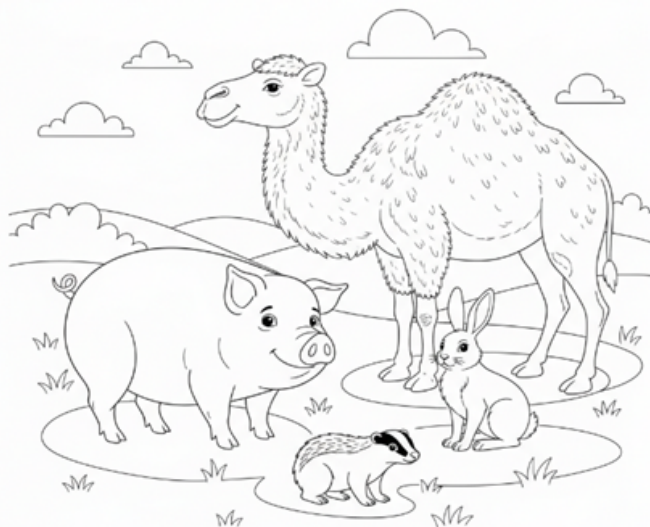

Moses called Mishael and Elshaphan, the sons of Uzziel, Aaron's uncle, and said to them, "Come near and take your relatives from the front of the sanctuary to a place outside the camp." So they came near and took them outside the camp by their tunics, as Moses had commanded. Then Moses said to Aaron and his sons Eleazar and Ithamar, "Do not shave your heads or tear your clothes, or you will die, and the wrath of the Lord will come upon the whole community. Your relatives, all the house of Israel, will mourn for the burning that the Lord has caused. Do not go outside the entrance to the Tent of Meeting, or you will die, for the Lord's anointing oil is on you." So they did as Moses had commanded. And Yahweh spoke to Aaron, saying, "You shall not drink wine or any intoxicant, neither you nor your sons, when you enter the Tent of Meeting, lest you die. This is a perpetual statute throughout your generations, for you must distinguish between the holy and the common, and between the unclean and the clean; and you must teach the Israelites all the laws that Yahweh gave you through Moses.

- Yahweh spoke to Moshe and Aaron, saying to them: Speak thus to the people of Israel: These are the creatures that you may eat from among all the animals of the earth: every animal that has divided hooves, with divisions in the hooves, and that chews the cud - of these you may eat.
- The following animals, however, among those that chew the cud or have divided hooves, you shall not eat: the camel—although it chews the cud, it does not have divided hooves: it is unclean for you; the badger—although it chews the cud, it does not have divided hooves: it is unclean for you; the hare—although it chews the cud, it does not have divided hooves: it is unclean for you; and the pig—although it has divided hooves, it does not chew the cud: it is unclean for you. You shall not eat their flesh or touch their carcasses; they are unclean for you.

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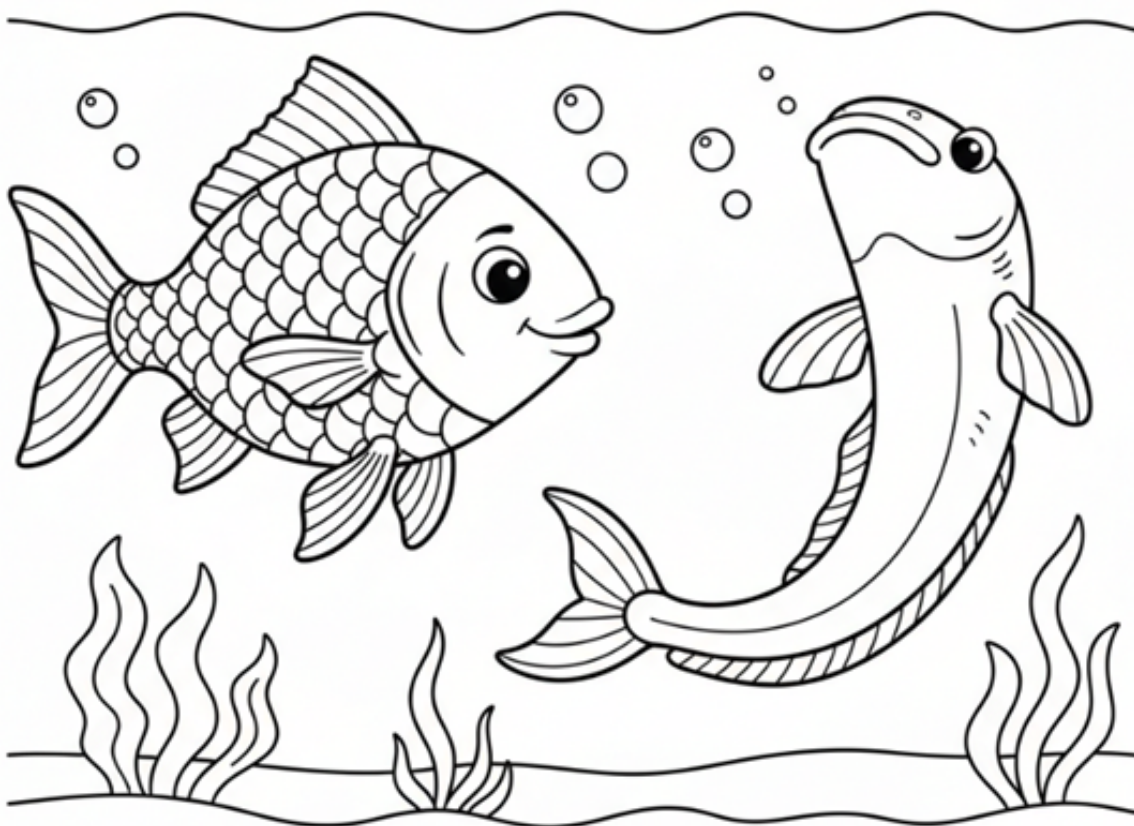

These you may eat of all that lives in the water: everything in the waters, whether in the seas or in the rivers, that has fins and scales—you may eat these. But everything in the seas or in the rivers that does not have fins and scales, among all that swarms in the water and among all the other creatures that are in the water—they are an abomination to you and will remain an abomination to you: you shall not eat their flesh and you shall abhor their carcasses. Everything in the water that does not have fins and scales will be an abomination to you.

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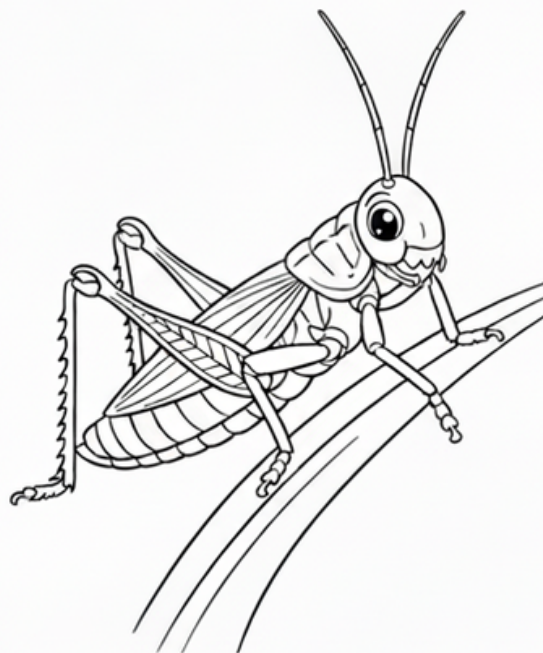

These are the birds you are to detest—you must not eat them, they are an abomination: the eagle, the vulture, and the black vulture; the kite, all kinds of falcons; all kinds of ravens; the ostrich, the owl, the seagull; all kinds of hawks; the little owl, the cormorant, and the great owl; the snowy owl, the pelican, and the swan; the stork; all kinds of herons; the hoopoe, and the bat. All winged insects that walk on all fours are an abomination to you. But these you may eat of all winged insects that walk on all fours: all those that have legs on their feet for hopping on the ground—of these you may eat the following: all kinds of locusts; all kinds of bald locusts; all kinds of crickets; and all kinds of grasshoppers. But every other winged insect that has four legs is an abomination to you.

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The following are unclean for you among those that crawl on the ground: the weasel, the mouse, and all kinds of lizards; the porcupine, the crocodile, the lizard, the gecko, and the chameleon. All reptiles that crawl on the ground are an abomination; you shall not eat them. You shall not eat, among all the reptiles that crawl on the ground, any that crawls on its belly, or any that walks on all fours, or any that has many legs; for they are an abomination.

- You must not make yourselves unclean by any creeping thing that creeps on the earth. For I am Yahweh your Elohim; you shall consecrate yourselves and be holy, for I am holy. You shall not make yourselves unclean by any creeping thing that moves on the earth. For I Yahweh am the one who brought you out of the land of Egypt to be your Elohim; you shall be holy, for I am holy.

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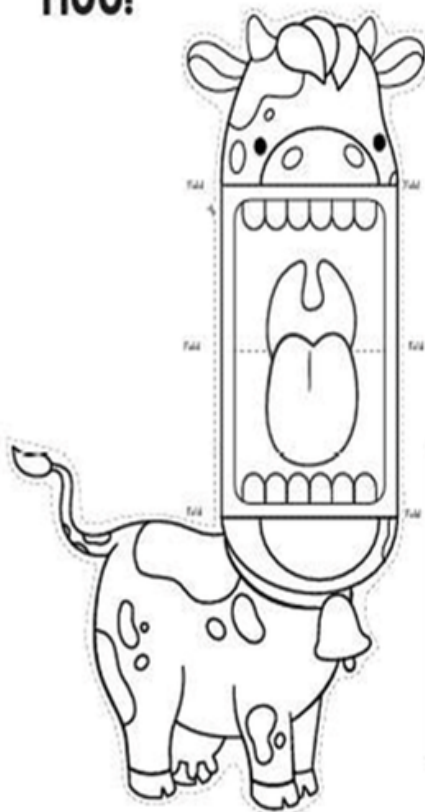

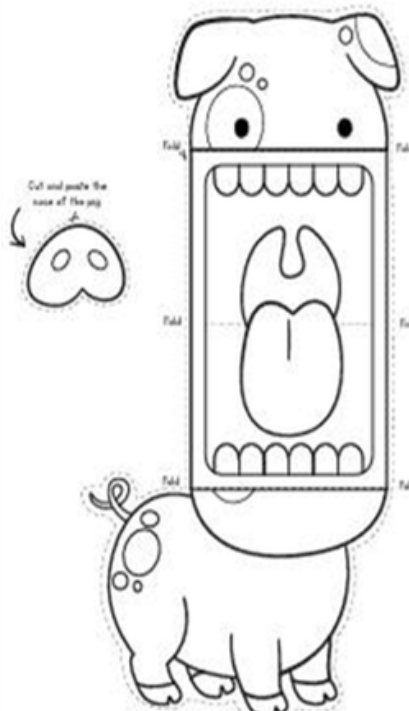

And glue the straps to the puppet.

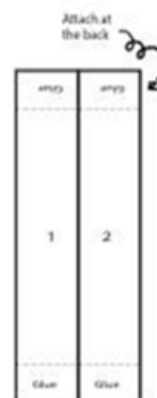


Easy Peasy Fun

And glue the straps to the puppet.



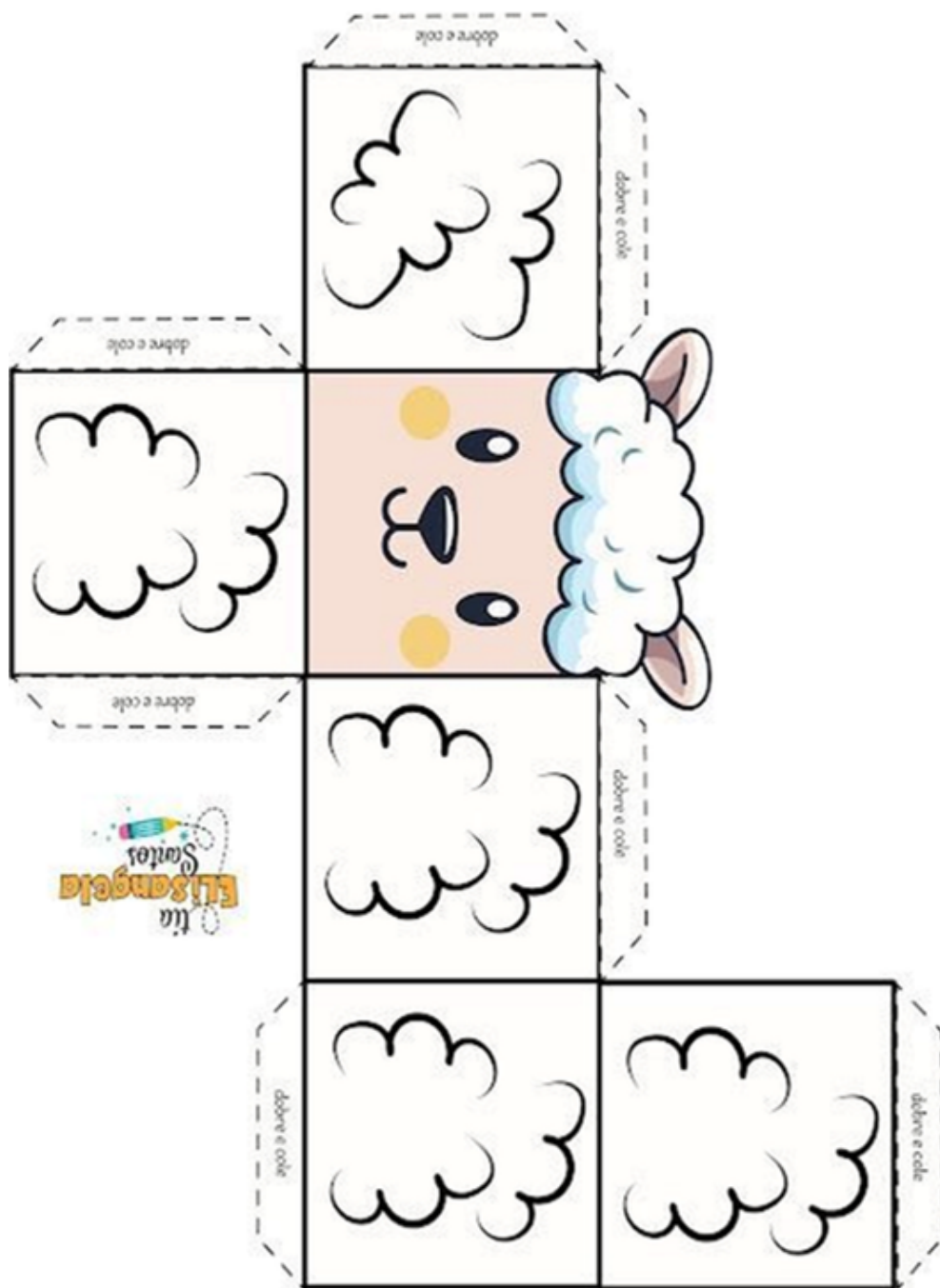
