Moses took inventory of the Mishkan. Ithamar, Aaron's son, counted and recorded every piece so that everything would be in its place. Bezalel and Oholiab did everything as Adonai had commanded, using gold, silver, and copper that all the people had joyfully given. They used so much gold that the entire interior shone, and silver to make the heavy bases that supported the pillars, ensuring that the house of Elohim would be very firm and sturdy. With the copper, they made the altar of sacrifice and the tent pegs that held up the tent. In the end, every silver hook and every copper nail was important, reminding us that when we work together and give what we have with love, we can build something great for Elohim!





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The sacred garments for Aaron were made, following Adonai's instructions. The ephod was crafted from gold and colored fabrics, and onyx stones were set in it, along with a breastplate of twelve stones representing the tribes of Israel. A blue robe was also made, with pomegranates and golden bells along its edges. In addition, tunics, turbans, and other garments were made for Aaron and his sons. Finally, the entire Tabernacle and its furnishings were brought to Moses, who blessed them after verifying that Adonai's command had been fulfilled.





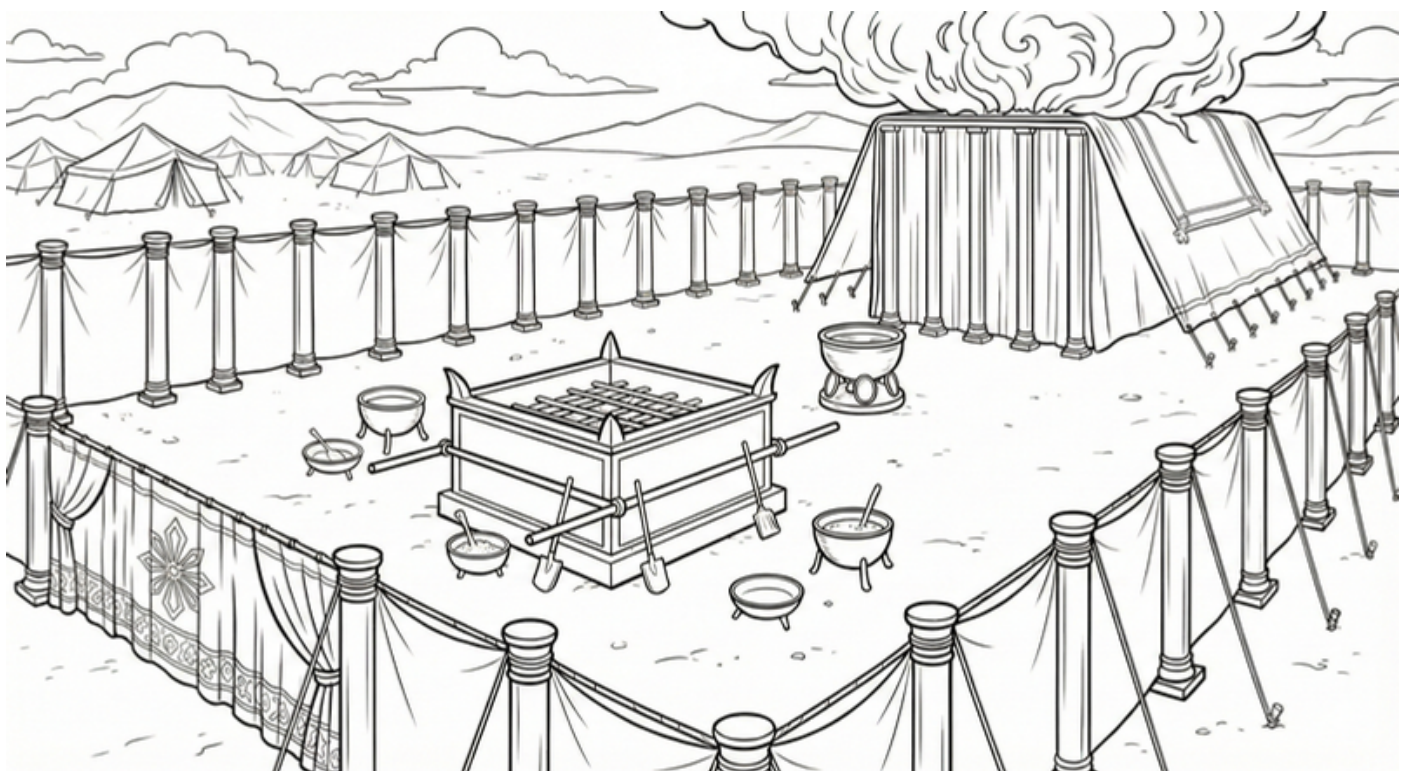

Adonai said to Moses: "On the first day of the first month, you shall erect the Mishkan and place the Ark, the Menorah, the table, and the altar in their exact places, and then sprinkle everything with special oil so that every corner may be holy." Aaron and his sons washed and put on their ceremonial robes to begin their new mission. Everything was so beautiful and orderly that the Mishkan was ready to receive God Himself!

As soon as Moses finished the work, something amazing happened: a huge, bright cloud descended from the sky and covered the tent—it was the glory of God filling everything! From that day on, that cloud accompanied them on their journey: by day it gave them cool shade, and by night it shone like a protective fire. When the cloud rose and moved, the people knew it was time to walk toward where the Eternal One directed them, and when the cloud remained still, they rested peacefully. God was finally dwelling among them!





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High Priest Craft



ARMS:

Cut and fold along the dotted line. Add glue to the back and glue.



BODY:

Cut, make a hole in the circles (light blue dot) with a pencil. Cut along the white line on the sides to attach the arms. Fold along the dotted line and glue the flaps (red dots).



HEAD:

Cut, fold along the dotted line, and attach with the flaps (red dots) to form the shape shown in the image



BE:

Cut and roll as shown in the picture; no need to glue.



FLOWERS:

Cut and fold along the dotted line. Add glue to the back and glue. Attach to the stick.



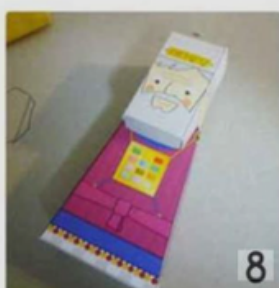
FEET:

Cut, fold along the dotted line, make a hole in the circles (light blue dot) with a pencil, and attach with the flaps (red dots) to form as shown in the picture



LEGS:

Roll up the legs and insert them into the feet.



BODY:

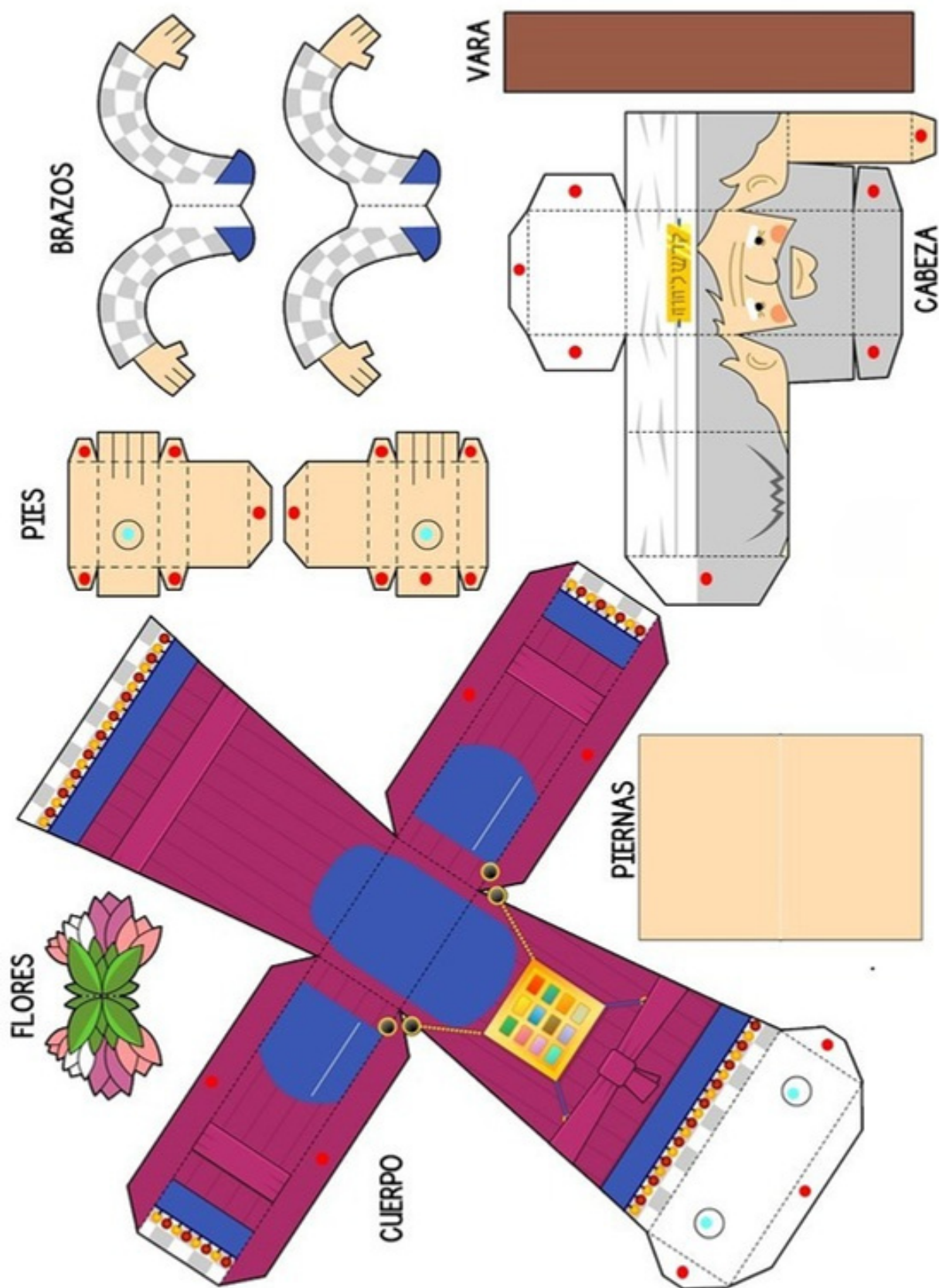
Attach the head to the body with glue.



LIMBS:

Insert the arms to the sides and the legs. No need to glue

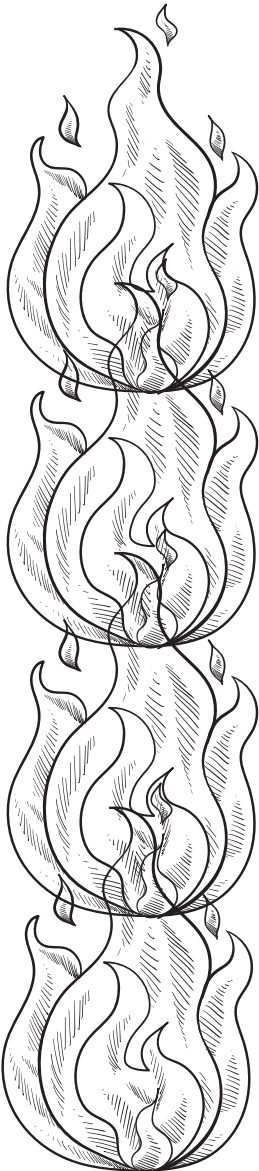

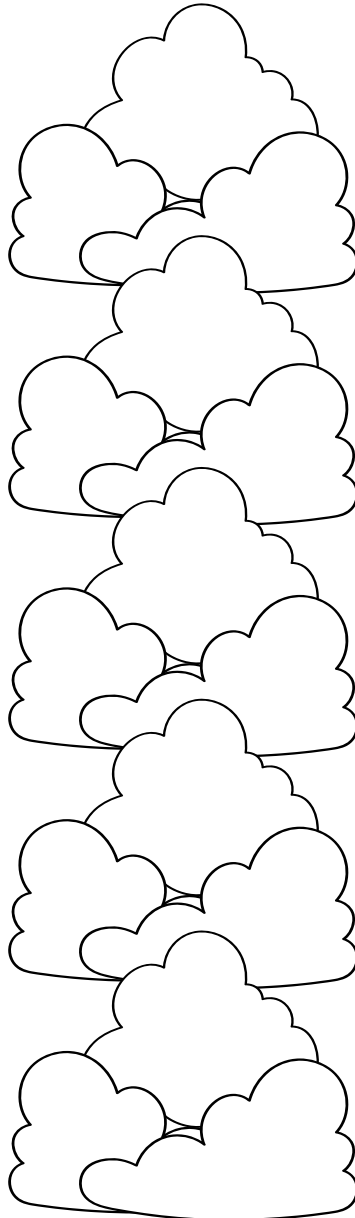
