- Observe campers behaviors, asses its appropriateness, enforce appropriate safety regulations and emergency procedures and apply appropriate behavior-management techniques
- Work collaboratively with other summer camp employees
- Prepare lesson plans for some activities
- Prepare for and actively participate in pre-camp training and meetings

Qualifications:

- One year out of high school, preferably with a year of college experience (working toward a degree in education)
- Previous experience as a camp counselor preferred but not required
- Energetic and fun spirited
- Love to interact and engage with kids
- Experience working with children
- Ability to teach and lead activities
- Leadership skills with the ability to work as a team
- Patient and willingness to learn
- Ability to communicate and work with a variety of personalities
- Ability to pass fingerprinting and background checks
- Available for training at end of June
