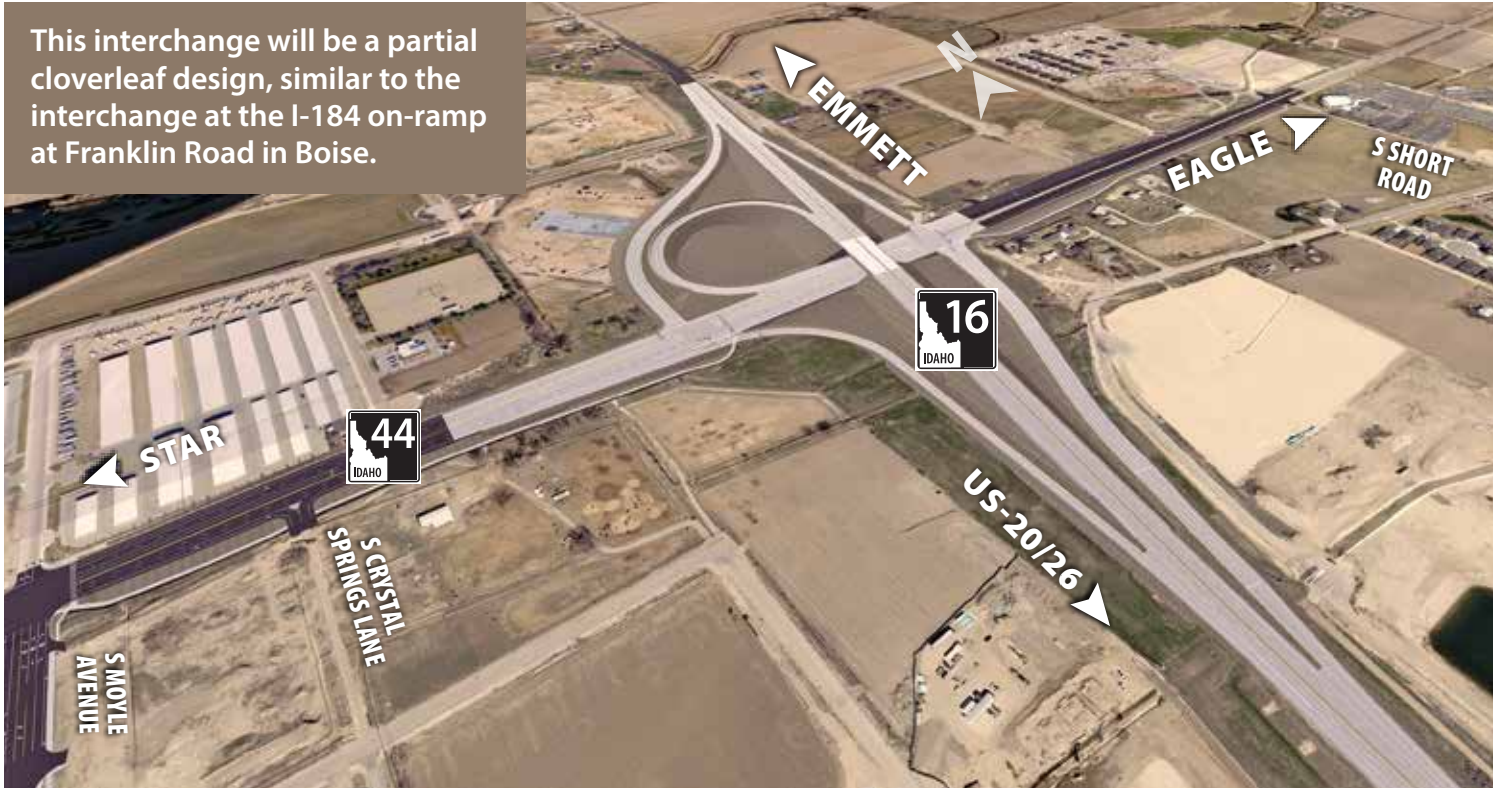


State Highway 16

44 Interchange

ITD is constructing a full interchange at State Highway 16 and State Highway 44 in Star. The new interchange will handle significantly more traffic than the existing intersection.

This interchange will be a partial cloverleaf design, similar to the interchange at the I-184 on-ramp at Franklin Road in Boise.



WHAT'S INCLUDED:

- SH-44 will be widened to three lanes in both directions immediately around the interchange.
- A new bridge will be constructed for SH-16 to cross over SH-44.
- New on- and off-ramps will allow traffic to travel between the two highways.
- A “loop” on-ramp will allow free-flow westbound to southbound traffic, eliminating a high-volume left turn.
- A pathway will be constructed on the south side of State Highway 44.

DURING CONSTRUCTION, MOTORISTS CAN EXPECT:

- At least one lane of travel in each direction on SH-16 and SH-44 will remain open.
- Occasional nighttime noise will be necessary.
- Access to local cross streets east and west of the intersection will change.
- Motorists can expect flagging, delays and occasional detours on SH-44 and SH-16.
