Can you believe Senior year has arrived?! The Counseling office is reaching out to inform students and families about upcoming programming and events pertaining to Seniors. Please read through this email thoroughly.

SCHOOL COUNSELOR CLASSROOM VISITS:

At this point, the School Counselors have facilitated classroom lessons with all Seniors during English classes to review post-secondary planning using Naviance and PA ACT 158 Pathway Requirements for graduation. Within Naviance, students were shown how to research college and career information as well as review their academic standing and how it relates to the application process. Students were also reminded how to sign up for rep visits with colleges, trade schools, and military recruiters that will be visiting Sun Valley this fall. ASVAB TESTING:

Sun Valley will be administering the ASVAB exam on September 28, 2023 for Seniors interested in pursuing a career in the military as well as any senior who received a letter recommending taking the ASVAB for a potential ACT 158 pathway. FAFSA NIGHT 2023:

The FAFSA Simplification Act reflects changes in how federal student aid will be awarded to students beginning in the 2024-25 application year and beyond.
