It is my pleasure to announce the appointment of Angel Peña as the agency's inaugural Deputy Chief Executive Officer. Angel was selected following a national executive search and brings nearly 25 years of experience in both the public and private sectors. His extensive background in transforming transit infrastructure, enhancing operational performance, and rebuilding public trust has prepared him well for this pivotal leadership role at RTD. As RTD's inaugural Deputy Chief Executive Officer, Angel will be tasked with advancing the agency's vision for an operationally safe, reliable, and customer-focused transit system. In his role at STV, Inc., he collaborated with transit agencies across the region, leveraging his public sector insights to help improve service delivery, project execution, and long-term infrastructure planning.

Angel holds a Master of Science in Engineering Management from The Catholic University of America in Washington, D.C. and a Bachelor of Science in Industrial Engineering from Universidad Yacambú in Venezuela. He is a graduate of the prestigious Leadership American Public Transportation Association (APTA) Class of 2017 and was recognized in Mass Transit Magazine's "Top 40 Under 40" for his contributions to the industry.

I am excited for Angel to join RTD during a time when the agency is doubling down on its efforts to get back to basics and prioritize maintaining assets in a state of good repair.
