- Montessori children tend to be self-directed and independent.
- Children who attend Montessori schools tend to become confident and competent. As adults, they normally become quite successful. But at the same time, they tend to be able to learn from their mistakes and remain open minded. When it comes to academics, Montessori provides students with skills that allow them to become independent adults and life-long learners.
