There are numerous opportunities to support Jim Luther New Hope Center.

**DONATIONS** which can be placed the gray bin in the gathering space:

- **Hygiene items:** There is an ongoing need for feminine hygiene pads (maxi & regular), bars of soap, toilet paper, small boxes of facial tissue (80 to 120 count), shampoo (12 to 15 oz.), disposable razors, Poise pads, hotel / sample size toiletries
- **Nourishment:** cereal, rice, and beans.
- **Methods to carry items:** Disposable plastic bags (Sentry, Pick n Save / Metro Market, Walmart, etc.), and used suitcases with rollers.
- Greeting cards and calendars
- **Monetary donations:** Checks can be written to the Jim Luther New Hope Center (formerly known as the St. Hyacinth Food Pantry).
