I understand that being cast in the school musical is a commitment. Until the show closes, I will work to fulfill my responsibilities for this production which are:

Student Initials ATTENDING ALL SCHEDULED REHEARSALS Students must attend all their rehearsals scheduled. Monthly calendars with rehearsal dates will be distributed to students. If a student is absent, it prevents others from getting the most out of rehearsal time. **Students are excused by a parent due to an illness or emergency only.** Excused absences can be made for medical appointments or pre-planned appointments or other events. (Parents and students are asked to supply conflicts during the audition process. Those conflicts influence the planning of rehearsals for best overall attendance. If a rehearsal is scheduled on a conflict a student/parent submitted, it is automatically excused.)

Student Initials PRACTICING GOOD BEHAVIOR Respecting others in this cast is necessary for a great performance. It is very important to create a team environment for a good production. If you are: disrespecting others, defying authority, disruptive during rehearsals or vandalizing school property, you will be removed from the cast.

Student Initials MAINTAINING GRADES Students will be required to keep their grades up. If a student has a D or lower; or poor behavior in any class, they will be placed on Academic Probation. We will give the student two weeks to raise their grades. If they fail to do so, they will be dropped from the show.
