You will check in with Mr. Lazarek to verify your spot and sketch. No paint drops until you have spoken to Mr. Lazarek.

You will need to bring your own materials.

You will use ONLY the materials you brought, highly discourage any sharing of materials.

You will be responsible for cleaning up after yourself

You will not have ANY access to the building

You will need to wear proper PPE (mask up!)

You will need to practice safe social distancing. This is our responsibility and Mr. Lazarek will be present to make sure you are practicing these protocols.
