Congratulations on being recommended to apply for the Harvard Prize Book!

Since 1910, the Harvard Prize Book award has been an important and effective way to engage talented young people and inform them of the opportunities at Harvard College in Cambridge, MA. Currently, the Harvard Prize Book is presented annually in over 1,700 schools around the world. Members of the Harvard Alumni Association through its various Clubs, purposely award the Prize Book to members of the junior, or next-to-graduating class each year. Students, if selected, often list the award on their college applications to distinguish themselves from other applicants to selective colleges and universities. Colleges around the world recognize the merit of the Harvard Prize Book and its student winners.

The Harvard Prize Book application is available on the next page. The criteria for recommendation and application include an un-weighted GPA of 3.75 with a minimum of six honors and/or AP classes and important extra-curricular achievements. Since the Prize Book recognizes a “variety of achievement,” you may have been recommended because of your contributions in non-academic areas as well as academic excellence.

**Application deadline**, which includes a faculty, advisor, or administrator’s recommendation and transcript, is as follows:

We will notify your school by April 1, 2020, if you have been selected to receive the prize. Winners are invited to attend a ceremony on the evening of Thursday, April 23, 2020, along with their parent(s) and school representative(s).

Please **list the number of words submitted at the bottom of your essay.** Winning students will read aloud excerpts from their essays to all attendees at the Prize Book Ceremony; *please bear this in mind* when preparing your response.
5. **Recommendation.** Administrator, advisor or faculty recommender: How has this student combined excellence in scholarship and character with achievement in other areas?
