Kentucky Wesleyan Rogers Fellows Scholarship

The Rogers Foundation will offer a minimum of 12 annual full scholarships to attend Kentucky Wesleyan College. These scholarships are open to current high school Seniors in the Clark County School District, as well as transferring college freshmen and sophomores enrolled in a college in Southern Nevada. PSWD Charles White Memorial Scholarship

\$2,000 | 02/28

This scholarship is for Unitarian Universalist Ministerial students from throughout the Pacific Western Region, with preference given to those who have a connection to the Pacific Southwest District.

Reno Rodeo Foundation Scholarship

\$1,000 – \$2,500 | 02/12
