



Congregational Meeting on June 19th

The Woodmont board met on Monday night and has now approved a proposed operating budget for the 2022-2023 year. Details are in this edition of The Spire. We will have our congregational meeting in the sanctuary at 10:40 a.m. on Father's Day, June 19th. At that time, we will vote on the proposed leadership slate and operating budget. Please let us know in advance if you have any questions about either. We are glad to answer them. We have now received **390 pledges** totaling roughly **3.2 Million dollars**. The board is proposing a 9.73 % increase in our budget. Coming out of the pandemic and two very difficult years, this is great news. This budget includes additional outreach funding, various merit-based raises for the hard-working staff, and funds to support our ongoing programs and ministry as well as this beautiful facility. Thank you for your generosity in making this new budget possible.

The board also accepted the property and finance committee's recommendation to move forward with ordering and funding a new chiller as well as

seven new rooftop hvac units that are very dated. The cost for this is roughly \$218,000 but it needs to be done asap based on the recommendation of the property committee. We are on borrowed time with the ones we have, and we look forward to getting these replaced. We are blessed with a beautiful church building but along with it comes the responsibility of ongoing maintenance and upkeep.

We have just started a brand new sermon series based on 1 & 2 Timothy titled "Leadership & Values." This week and next week on Wednesday night, we are doing intentional leadership training in the chapel at 6 p.m. These sessions are open to anybody. Ian Morgan Cron will be our guest on Wednesday, June 15th, to discuss the Enneagram & Leadership. He is well known author and speaker. Leaders are all different, and they lead from different strengths and personalities. Knowing ourselves and our own tendencies is crucial when it comes to leading others. On Sunday, I kicked off the series by sharing with you what I see as the "Top 5 Qualities of a Christian Leader."

1. Christian leaders are servants first.
2. Christian leaders are grounded in their faith and always willing to grow and learn.
3. Christian leaders must be more concerned with the common good than with their own personal agenda.
4. Christian leaders must work towards and sacrifice for a vision.
5. Christian leaders ALWAYS point others to Jesus Christ & his redemptive love.

In the coming weeks, we will have a lot more to say about Christian leadership and the values we should embody. I encourage you to read the pastoral epistles of 1 & 2 Timothy where Paul offers great wisdom on what it means to lead in the church.


I hope you will enjoy the summer months and the slower pace of life. Rest and be safe if you are travelling.




