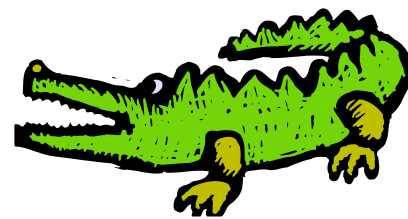

Team Registration Online

Returning families should have received an email last week with information on logging into our web site. If you are a **returning family**, please do **NOT** create a **NEW** account. Your information has already been populated and an account has been set up for you. You should be able to login and update your password, account information and email address, as needed. In the SMS spot, please add your mobile number and choose your mobile provider. This will allow us to text you important updates during the swim season.

Accounts will be "approved" once payment for swim team registration is received. You may pay via check or PayPal. **Cost is \$75 per swimmer.**

Practices Begin on Monday, May 20th

All age groups begin practice on May 21st (see schedule at left). All children should wear swimsuits and bring sneakers and socks. The pool will be chilly and the weather may be stormy, so an extra towel may be helpful.

Morning practices begin on June 12th. For morning practice, ages 7-10 and 11 and up will be together 9:00-10:15am; 6 and under will be 10:15-11:00am.

Volunteering is Part of the Deal

Swim team parents are required to volunteer at the Time Trials and at 3 meets. Meets cannot be conducted effectively without your help. Most positions are very easy and require no training. However, a few do require some minor, simple training that we will provide at your convenience. We will be providing a sign-up for volunteering in the coming weeks.



TIME TRIALS is June 1st and it's a great opportunity to try out a new job assignment. For every family that declares for time trials, we will need one parent volunteer. Job assignments will be posted at the pool the morning of time trials. We may ask parents to try a job that they have not done in the past. We have a number of important roles at meets that need to be filled, and time trials is the perfect time to learn something new without the pressure of a full meet. After time trials, we encourage parents to put their newly learned skill to use and sign-up for the new job....at least once! This will keep our meets running smoothly year-to-year.


Declaring for Meets

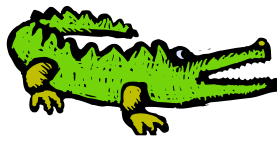
This year, for each meet you will need to declare “yes” or “no” whether your swimmer(s) can attend. To make this easy for you, you can go ahead and declare your swimmer(s) as a “yes” or “no” for ALL swim meets at the beginning of the season. It is important that you follow this process. Swimmers who do not declare will not be put in the meet lineup. Reminders will be sent from our Team Unify system 7 days before the deadline for each meet. The signup deadline is two days before the meet (ex: Sunday for a Tuesday meet).



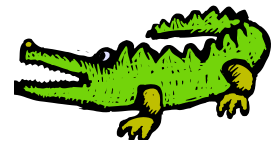

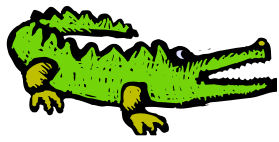


Head Coach Brendan Betts

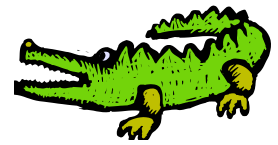
Brendan is excited to be back for his third season with Greystone. Prior to joining Greystone, Brendan was a year round swim coach in the Triangle for nine years. For the last three years he has been teaching swim lessons for Triangle Swim School. He also runs the Gators Fall and Winter Clinics and gives private swim instruction to both kids and adults.

He spent five years with New Wave Swim Team and four years as the Head Age Group Coach of the Y of the Triangle Area Swim Team (YOTA). In his time at Wave he developed and trained swimmers of all ability levels. While at the Wave he also coached swimmers to over 30 team records and 13 state records. During each of the four years Brendan coached at YOTA the team had an increase in qualifiers for the major age group championship meets. He also led YOTA to their highest ever finishes this decade at the NCS Short Course Age Group Championships (4th) and the NCS Long Course Age Group Championships (3rd) in 2008. Before coming to YOTA, Brendan worked with one of the most dominant USA Swimming programs in the southeast and the entire nation -Dynamo Swim Club in Atlanta, Georgia. During his time at Dynamo, Brendan worked primarily with their top 12 & under swimmers, as well as with their developmental senior swimmers and their Masters group. While in Atlanta, Brendan also spent time as a volunteer assistant with the Emory University men's and women's swimming teams, both of which are NCAA Division III national powers. Brendan has worked with some of the top coaches in the country, including Ed Spencer, former Head Coach at Dynamo, who is now serving as a Master Coach with USA Swimming. He has also worked with Pete Morgan at Curl-Burke who produced Olympic breaststroker Ed Moses.

Brendan holds a B.A. degree in Political Science from the College of Charleston. He is an ASCA level 4 certified coach. Brendan and his wife Erica have two boys, Hayden, age 8, and Ryder, age 6. They also have two Labrador Retrievers, Oliver and Gladys.
