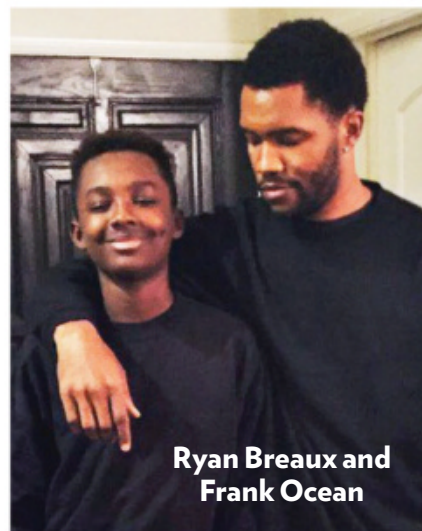
Health

The *Ghostbusters* star is devoted to helping provide food and clothing to those in need

I've been working with the White Pony Express since it began seven years ago, when my closest friend Mary Brooks, who was the executive director, got me involved. The organization, founded by Dr. Carol Weyland Conner and based in Contra Costa County, Calif., started as a food rescue operation picking up fresh surplus food and delivering it to those in need. In 2014 they expanded to include the White Pony General Store, where clothing, toys and books are freely distributed through mobile boutiques. The charitable organization has distributed over 500,000 items and over 12 million lbs. of food. When the pandemic hit, I began sewing masks and selling them to help raise money and supply the staff and volunteers with needed protection. I've sat with people who have lost their homes and have no food to eat—once you experience that human-to-human exchange, it changes you and makes you want to do everything in your power to help. —Reported By MIA McNIECE
