

## Basic Guidelines for Safe Church Service Outside

### What You Must Know:

- You need your own lawn chair and mask.
- You will be directed where to park and where to place your chair for physical distancing.
- Consider a “sunbrella” if you are sun sensitive.
- If you choose to receive communion, you will be individually directed by the usher to come up to receive your combined communion elements and then return to your seat, maintaining appropriate distance as you move. We will consume in unison once everyone has received.
- Bathroom facilities will NOT be available. Please plan accordingly.
- No smoking.
- Please, no lingering inside the protective area. We are trying to keep movement limited and are busy setting up and checking media.
- Please be safe and allow us to work out some wrinkles. We are constantly brainstorming how to do this better.

#### 1. Safety Guidelines:

##### Masks:

- **Mask Types:** Must be two layers of material or surgical type. Masks with a valve must have 2 layers of material behind them or they will not meet standards of safety.
- **Mask Wear:           Masks MUST be worn at all times!**  
The only except is immediately before and during taking communion. Your mask must be replaced immediately after receiving communion.  
Mask must fit over nose and mouth and remain over both.

#### 2. Parking:

Democracy Lane is closed during construction. You will need to enter the church parking lot from the access road behind the shopping center off of Old Lee Hwy. You will be directed to a parking space by the ushers.

#### 3. Communion:

An usher will stand by the station and direct participants to the elements. Participants will pick it up and return to their seat

#### 4. Parishioner placement:

The Usher will direct you. Chairs will be offset on the markers which are at least 6 feet apart from each other and 12 feet from the Altar. If two or more people choose to sit together, they will be directed to the 3<sup>rd</sup> row and also spaced 6 feet from the closest other person or group.
