Bible Pride ~ The Bible Says...

*Too many people spend too much time
railing against what they believe is wrong
instead of doing what they know is right.*

First Reading ~ Micah 6:8

Listen, O mortal, God has told you what is good, and what does God require of you but to do justice, to love kindness, and to walk humbly with your God?

Second Reading ~ Mark 12:28-31

You can quote the Bible before killing a person to justify the killing. "An eye for an eye and a tooth for a tooth," the Bible says.
