Show Up

There are so many ways to give, to make an offering. I have learned that the most important means is simply showing up. In our recent Inquirer’s Class, someone asked... “What can we do?”. My response came quickly, without much thought, and from a place much larger then me: “Show up. Be present. Take the time to come to church on Sundays.” And it’s true. The most significant gift is the offering of your time, your self. Your Body. As Glennon Doyle said about Life (and you can substitute church for life):

*The secret of life is not about knowing what to say or do.
The secret is simply to show up. It's about witnessing it all, even the pain,
and letting it touch you and make you not harder, but more tender.
Showing up, feeling it all— it's how, for me, everything turns holy.*

You may show up for yourself some Sundays, or you may show up for someone else, your very presence providing encouragement and strength for another. Sometimes you know exactly why you are there, sometimes you will never know, but your presence matters.

Do Something

The next step of an offering is doing something, offering not only the gift of your presence, but ALL of your body, your hands, feet, voice, skills, gifts, talents... My dad would always say, “When you don’t know what to do, do the dishes”. Do something! Sing loud. Bring Food. Greet strangers- guests. Participate. Engage. Become active in an outreach ministry. And there are always dishes. ☺
