First Reading ~ *Jeremiah 1:4-10*

Now the word of YHWH came to me and said:
"Before I formed you in the womb, I chose you.
Before you were born, I dedicated you.
I appointed you as a prophet to the nations."
I said, "But Sovereign YHWH!
I don't know how to speak! I'm too young!"

But YHWH said,
"Do not say, 'I am too young.'
Now, go wherever I send you.
And say whatever I command you.
Do not fear anyone,
for I am with you to protect you.
It is YHWH who speaks."

Then YHWH touched my mouth and said to me,
"Look, I am putting my words in your mouth.
This day I appoint you

Second Reading ~ *Luke 4:18-24*

"The Spirit of our God is upon me:
because the Most High has anointed me
to bring Good News to those who are poor.
God has sent me to proclaim liberty to those held captive,
recovery of sight to those who are blind,
and release to those in prison--
to proclaim the year of our God's favor."
