



PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, The Stonewall Riots began in New York on June 28, 1969, and are regarded as a catalyst for the lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, and queer, also known as LGBTQ+ movement for civil rights in the United States; and

WHEREAS, June is celebrated as LGBTQ+ Pride Month nationwide; and

WHEREAS, The City of Fairfax has a diverse LGBTQ+ community that includes people of all ethnicities, religions and professions actively engaged in every aspect of life in our community; and

WHEREAS, The City of Fairfax is a proud center for the Transgender Education Association of Greater Washington, and The Metropolitan Community Church of Northern Virginia, part of the first denomination formed by and for LGBTQ+ people in 1968; and

WHEREAS, Everyone should be able to live without fear of prejudice, discrimination, violence or hatred based on gender identity or sexual orientation; and

WHEREAS, The City of Fairfax urges the General Assembly to pass legislation eliminating discrimination and barriers to all residents regardless of gender identity/expression or sexual orientation affecting employment, housing, public safety, policing, health care, education and recognition of family relationships.



LGBTQ+ Pride Month


in the City of Fairfax and urges all residents to respect and honor our diverse community and celebrate and build a culture of inclusiveness and acceptance.
