When we accept this, we realize that there is ultimately no easy way out, no way to actually escape the necessity of theology in our lives. Theology is something we do, not just something we believe. The same is true for church. At our community gatherings on Sunday, we have a communal meal, the Eucharist the essence of Christ. When we allow everyone to participate, it says something about God. Everything we do says something about God.
