First Reading ~ *Matthew 1:18-25*

This is how the birth of Jesus came about. His mother, Mary, was engaged to Joseph, but before they lived together, Mary realized she was pregnant through the Holy Spirit. Joseph, her husband, an upright person unwilling to disgrace her publicly, decided to break the marriage agreement with her secretly. But after Joseph had considered this, the angel of God appeared to him in a dream, and said, “Joseph, descendant of David, don’t be afraid to take Mary as your wife; it is by the Holy Spirit she has conceived this child. She is to have a son, and you are to name him Jesus – ‘Salvation’, ‘God Saves’ –because he will save the people from their sins.” All this happened to fulfill what God has said through the prophet: “The virgin will be with child and give birth, and the child shall be named Emmanuel” - a name that means ‘God With Us’.

When Joseph awoke, he did as the angel of God had directed, and took Mary into his home as his wife. He had no union with her as her husband until she had given birth; she had a son, and they named the baby Jesus.

When Joseph first learned about Mary, what was Joseph going to do? "Just do what the Bible says. You can't go wrong if you do what the Bible says." I have heard that all my life. Well, I will tell you what it says. From Deuteronomy 22: "She is to be taken out and stoned to death in front of the people." That is what the Bible says. I get sick and tired of people always thumping the Bible and saying, "Just do what the Good Book says."

Joseph is a good man, and he rises to a point that is absolutely remarkable for his day and time. He loves his Bible and he knows his Bible and bless his heart for that. But he reads his Bible through a certain kind of lens, the lens of the character and nature of a God who is kind and loving. Therefore, he says with his action, "I will not harm her, abuse her, expose her publically, shame her, ridicule her, or demean her value, her dignity, or her worth. I will protect her. I will save her." Where does it say that in your Bible, Joseph? I'll tell you where it says that. In the very nature and character of God.
