Teams of 4-6 will then descend upon downtown Chicago to see who can complete the most tasks that make others smile: caroling at Cloud Gate, giving "thank you" notes to city workers, staging scenes from the Nutcracker...the list goes on! Our reach will be greater than ever with remote spectators tuning in from home – completing their own challenges and following our live updates on social media. Finally, we will regroup indoors for an awards ceremony and spirited send-off. We expect a sold-out event of 150-200 participants, so secure your tickets today!
