### **EXHIBITS:**

#### **HULL TOWN HALL:** Started in 2014

For years the Town Hall exhibit involved 2 artists to display their artwork in the front vestibule for 3 months, with no fee or commission. However, the Hull Town Hall is moving into the former Hull Middle School building sometime in the spring of 2026. HA will again be provided space in their new facility to showcase and sell artwork. **CURATOR: Marianne Buckley-Curran**

#### **NANTASKET BEACH RESORT:** Started in 2015

- **WHERE:** 45 Hull Shore Drive, Hull. The gallery is in a hallway off the main lobby.
- **WHEN:** Varies: exhibits are usually for two months. Space is available for approximately 25-40 pieces. The "Call for Art" goes out a few weeks prior to the exhibit's start.
- **WHO:** Any HA member may participate and may enter any number of pieces.
- **FEE:** \$10 per piece or 3 for \$25; 4 for \$35; 5 for \$45; 6 for \$50. No commission is taken on regular exhibits.
- **THEME:** Varies each exhibit.
- **CURATOR: Betsy Taylor & Exhibits Committee**

#### **The 5th Annual Regional Juried Art Show:** at the Resort

**When:** in the spring for 5 weeks.

**Who:** The juried show is open to all HA members and non-members. The "Call for Art" usually goes out 6 weeks before the final juror's selection is announced.

**Fees:** Entry fees differ for HA members and nonmembers. Fees for 2026 TBD

**CURATOR: Lara Williams & committee**

#### **HULL PUBLIC LIBRARY:** Started in 2022

- **WHERE:** 9 Main Street, Hull, upstairs in the "gallery" room
- **WHEN:** Varies, usually every 2 months. Space for 10 to 20 pieces of artwork.

- **WHO:** All HA members may submit up to 2 pieces of artwork - jpegs sent to curator(s) for selection (if there are too many submissions).
- **FEE:** \$10 per accepted entry - no commission; \$50 for a solo exhibitor.
- **THEME:** Varies by exhibit.
- **CURATOR:** *Betsy Taylor / Bella Kristal* & Exhibits Committee

**GALLERY NANTASKET:** Established in 2018

- **WHERE:** 121 Nantasket Ave, Hull, on the ground floor of the Ocean Place Condos.
- **WHEN:** Year-round. Open Wednesday to Sunday, 10 AM to 4 PM. The Gallery's artwork is changed every three months. There is space for 26 artists each season. (Spring, Summer, Fall, & Winter) Details will be in each "Call for Artists" that is sent out a few weeks prior to the new season.
- **WHO:** All HA members, both wall artists and crafters, may request to participate.
- **FEE:** "Seasonal Artists" - \$50 per month for 3 months; "Annual Artists" - \$25 per month with a one-year commitment to work in the Gallery.
- **CURATOR:** *Betsy Taylor. Managers: Sandra Weeks - Operations / Terry McMahon - Finances*

**EVENTS:**

**OPEN STUDIOS:** 2026 is our 30th year

- **WHERE:** Participating artists open their home studios in Hull and adjacent towns to the public to exhibit and sell their artwork.
- **WHEN:** Takes place twice a year; on weekends, usually in July and either August or September, from 10 AM to 4 PM. The "Call for Artists" is usually sent in April and is due in May.
- **WHO:** Any HA member may participate.
- **FEE:** The fee for 2025: \$100. Participants must volunteer 10 hours of their time to help organize the event and promote it to the general public.
- **THEME:** None
- **CURATORS:** *OS Planning Team*

**ARTISAN CRAFT SHOW:** Started in 2022

The 2026, 5th Annual Artisan Craft Show will likely be held in October from 10 AM to 4 PM at the Hull Yacht Club. Applications are usually sent out in August. 20 artists are accepted by jury to participate. The event is open to HA members and non-HA members.

**CURATOR:** *Sue Bradley & Committee*

**HA's PLEIN AIR EVENT AND ART SHOW:** Started in 2024

This event is held each May, with registration open to any artist wanting to participate. Artists paint from locations of their choice in the Hull / Nantasket Beach area. There is a "Wet Paint" sale at the end of the event. HA may take a commission on the sale.

**CURATORS:** *HA Events Committee*

**ARTISAN ATTIC: Mary Jeannette Murray Bathhouse - New TBD**

A new opportunity for artists / crafters to clean out their studios, attics, and storage closets and sell their extra supplies.

**POETIC CANVAS: New - Late Spring, 2026**

Artists choose one of 15 submitted original poems as inspiration to create a representative piece — any art form is acceptable: painting, mixed media, sculpture, etc. A reception and sale will follow.
