When will the pool shutdown take place?

The pool is scheduled to close on August 31, 2026, and is expected to reopen at the end of December 2026.

What improvements are being made during the shutdown?

During the closure, the following improvements will be completed:

- Replacement of the pool deck flooring
- Replacement of the pool plaster/pool floor
- Replacement of the whirlpool tile
- Installation of new children's play features, including:
 - Two children's slides
 - Tot swing
 - New spray feature
- Mechanical room improvements
- Update LED lighting

What are my options if I would still like to swim?

Members are welcome to use the West Washington Branch in West Bend, which features a 6-lane lap pool available for lap swimming and a family adventure pool. No reservations are required.
