

# 2026.27 ND PROGRAMS



## ABOUT THIS PROGRAM

Crew is a non-competitive performance program that offers dancers (K-12<sup>th</sup> grade) the opportunity to explore their love for dance, work as a team, and gain additional performance experience. Instructional focus is on individual development in quality of movement, coordination, musicality, and group execution. This program can also be an avenue for dancers to determine if pursuing additional dance opportunities will be part of their dance journey. No auditions required.

## CREW INFORMATION

### REGISTRATION

Registration for the 2026-2027 Crew Program and Nebraska Dance recreational classes will open on April 28<sup>th</sup> for returning families and April 30<sup>th</sup> for new families.

Please note that students enrolling in Crew classes must meet the minimum requirement of 2.25 class hours per week for Tracks A-D and 1.5 class hours per week for Minis. If a desired class is full, please add your student to the waitlist so we can accurately track placement needs.

If your student is auditioning for a competitive program, you may initially enroll in Crew classes and adjust the schedule once audition results are released.

### DANCES & EVENTS

Each Crew class will work toward mastering a single dance routine, which will be performed at all ND events.

In-studio performances include Halloween and Holiday Performance Weeks where Crew performs alongside our ND recreational classes. Crew will have a group Pep Rally to kick off the performance season in late winter for family and friends to enjoy! Stage performances for Crew dances are ND's Winter Showcase, Benefit Concert, and Dance Concert.

### PROGRAM COSTS

Estimated general expenses for the Crew dance year are **\$295**. These expenses include: Program Leadership and Administration, t-shirt, Kick-Off Party, Crew Pep Rally, Winter Showcase, Benefit Concert, and End of the Year Celebration. This amount will be due on September 23rd.

Costume fees range from **\$100-\$200** per class/dance. Upon registration, a registration fee of **\$40-\$50** is due, as well as a deposit on each costume to hold your spot in class. Balance for costumes are due in November.

### MINI CREW | K-1<sup>ST</sup> GRADE

Mini Crew is a great introduction to additional performance opportunities as young dancers experience the stage multiple times throughout the year. Dancers grow in confidence and stage presence, and are often exposed to slightly more complex choreography to challenge their coordination and skill.

Enrollment requirements include one Mini Crew Jazz class (45 minutes per week) as well as one ND class of your choice (45 minutes per week).

### CREW JAZZ (90 MINUTES)

Dancers learn and refine their jazz piece, develop technique (turns, leaps, kicks, etc.), increase flexibility, improve movement quality and more in this extended class. Crew Jazz will challenge group and individual development, as well as foster a culture of teamwork and social growth.

### CREW HIP HOP (45 MINUTES)

Experience the world of hip hop with upbeat and fun music. In this class, dancers will learn and perfect their hip hop routine while improving hip hop technique and execution. Crew Hip Hop brings an exciting energy to each show!

### CREW LYRICAL (45 MINUTES)

Experience lyrical dance, which combines the fundamentals from both ballet and jazz technique, with choreography set to soft and inspiring music. Dancers in Crew Lyrical will learn and rehearse their lyrical performance routine while growing in emotional expression of facial and body language.

### CREW TAP (45 MINUTES)

Experience tap technique through warm-up, center and across the floor rhythmic exercises and choreography set to upbeat music. Dancers in Crew Tap will learn and rehearse their tap performance routine while growing in tap technique.

Enrollment requirements include your choice of any combination of Crew and/or ND classes, that MUST total 2 hours 15 minutes each week and MUST include at least one Crew class. Dancers can participate in ALL Crew classes for their age group if they wish.\*

\*New this year! **D Track Students only** may participate in any Crew classes of their choosing without fulfilling the minimum class requirement.

6th grade students may choose to dance in B or C track classes.

## EXAMPLES OF POTENTIAL WEEKLY SCHEDULES

Crew A Jazz (90 minutes) and a Crew A Hip Hop (45 minutes)

Crew A Hip Hop (45 minutes), Crew A Lyrical (45 minutes), and an ND Track A Class (45 minutes)

Crew B Lyrical (45 minutes), ND Track B Class (45 minutes), and an ND Track B Class (45 minutes)

Crew C/D Jazz (90 minutes) and an ND Track C/D Class (45 minutes)
