2026-2027 REGISTRATION & TUITION

Registration fee and costume deposits are paid at time of registration.

- Registration Fee is \$40 per family through July 31st, and \$50 per family starting on August 1st
- Dance Concert costume deposit is \$40 per dancer, per costume (one costume deposit per class added)

Registration fees are non-refundable. If a concert class is dropped after November 15th, costume fees will not be refunded. Your first monthly tuition payment will be charged on September 1st. All tuition fees are non-refundable.

Nebraska Dance calendar is based on 35 weeks of scheduled classes and an end of year dance concert in early June. The cost for a class is an annual price, but for the convenience of our families, it is broken down and spread out over nine (9) monthly installments (September-May). The first installment will be charged to your account on September 1, 2026 and the final installment will be charged on May 1, 2027. * If the 1st of the month falls on a weekend, tuition will be charged on the first business day of that month.

2026-2027 ND CLASS TUITION RATES

HOURS PER WEEK	TUITION RATE
1 class 45 minutes	\$74 per month
2 classes 1 hour 30 minutes	\$126 per month
3 classes 2 hours 15 minutes	\$173 per month
4 classes 3 hours	\$210 per month

- 90 minute classes count as two 45 minute classes on the tuition rate scale.
- Additional students in the same immediate family receive a 10% discount. The student with the highest number of classes is counted as student one.
- Please note that your online account will show tuition at 25.26 tuition rates until May 31st, 2026. Tuition rates will be updated to 26.27 rates in June of 2026.

*For peanut, tiny and mini classes, dancers must reach the minimum age for class by October 1st, 2026 in order to register for classes in that age group for the 26.27 dance year. Dancers who miss the age cut-off may take classes in age track for their current age at the start of the season.

**Dancers in 6th grade may choose Track B or Track C classes.

ADDING/DROPPING CLASSES

To make changes to your schedule, you must fill out the online "Change/Cancellation Form". Please email info@nebraskadance.com, visit our website, or see the front desk to have this form sent to you.

THIS FORM MUST BE TURNED IN ONLINE BY THE 15TH OF THE MONTH IN ORDER TO CANCEL THE FOLLOWING MONTH'S TUITION.

Example - Must be turned in by October 15th to cancel November tuition. If the form is not turned in by the 15th of the month, your account will be charged for the following month's tuition. All tuition is non-refundable. Credit on account may be offered for cancelled workshops or sessions if two weeks notice is given.

November 17th is the last day to add a 26.27 monthly enrollment class and still participate in the dance concert piece for that class, and also the last day to drop a class and not be charged the dance concert costume balance for that class.

COSTUME PAYMENTS

Dance concert ticketing has moved to online ticketing with reserved seating! This prevents the need for waiting in line and allows families to choose their seats ahead of time. Tickets will be purchased through the online ticketing system. Tickets will range from \$18 to \$22 per show plus online ticketing fees, depending on the location of the seat.

The Costume Balance will be due November 18th. We will email information regarding this payment, which will be charged to your payment method on file in your account by the 18th of November. The costume balance is the total costume cost less costume deposit paid at time of registration. You will receive an email indicating the balance due for all costumes prior to the balance being charged to your payment method on file. Each recreational class costume will cost approximately \$95-\$150.

Costume Fees will be charged automatically to your payment method on file. We highly recommend that all students participate in the dance concerts the weekend of June 1st-7th, 2027. If for any reason your student is not able to participate in the dance concert, please complete the form that will be sent out to all families prior to Nov 15th to avoid being charged for the costume balance. You will be asked to fill out a form confirming and documenting your non-participation.

If the payment of the costume balance is not paid by November 18th, COSTUME(S) WILL NOT BE ORDERED FOR YOUR STUDENT. If costume(s) are not ordered, they will be unable to participate in the dance concert or pictures. When you do pay for a costume deposit at registration, you understand that you are obligated to purchase the costume and pay the remaining balance in November for each class that your student is dancing in the dance concert, unless a class cancellation form has been completed by November 15th. Please note that costume fee(s) are non-refundable.

Costumes are distributed and/or available for pickup at the studio approximately 1-2 weeks prior to dress rehearsal/picture week in the spring.

PERSONAL BELONGINGS

Please label everything you bring to dance! We do have a lost and found. Please make sure you check it for lost items. Nebraska Dance is NOT RESPONSIBLE for lost or damaged personal items for either parents, students, or relatives/friends. Please DO NOT bring valuables to the studio.

MAKE UP CLASSES

If your student has to miss a class, they are welcome to schedule a make-up in another class in their track at or below their level. The class needs to be made up within ONE MONTH of the missed class. Please schedule your recreational make-up class in advance by emailing info@nebraskadance.com.

SNOW/COLD/SEVERE WEATHER DAYS

We generally follow the local PUBLIC SCHOOLS CLOSING to make a decision on our classes to be canceled for class that day. However, if the weather seems to be clearing up throughout the day, we will make a decision by 2:00pm. If school is in session and the weather conditions become poor throughout the day, we will make a decision by 2:00pm. Families registered for classes will be emailed a message in the case of cancellation and we also post on social media. We will most likely NOT cancel if the school districts close for 'cold days'. Classes may be canceled if severe weather is expected. If we choose to have our classes and you feel it is too dangerous to drive, we support that decision. We do not credit, refund or prorate tuition for classes canceled due to inclement weather. The first time a particular day of the week has a snow day, you are welcome to schedule a make-up class if you choose. If that same day of the week has more than one snow day, we will offer a make-up class date over spring break.

POSITIVE ENVIRONMENT

At Nebraska Dance, we strive to create a positive and healthy environment for all of our students and we appreciate your support in making that possible. Please maintain a positive attitude while in the studio, as it helps shape the experience for everyone. If you have any concerns, we encourage you to schedule an appointment with a Director so we can address them together.

PETS

Pets or animals are not allowed in the buildings, this includes lobby and vestibule areas.

DANCE CONCERT INFORMATION

We will plan to hold our annual dance concerts the week of June 1st-7th, 2027. This week includes dress rehearsal and picture times for each class as well. Exact dates and times for each show, dress rehearsal group, as well as the venue for the dance concert are TBA.

IMPORTANT DANCE CONCERT NOTE

Please carefully review the dance concert shows above. When you select your classes, you are also selecting which concert your student(s) will perform in. Track A, B, C/D classes are all in the concert for their age group regardless of the day of the week classes are held. Peanut, Tiny and Mini Classes are assigned to a different show depending on the class day of the week. Please be aware that tickets are required for each dance concert show you attend, and ticket prices range from \$18-\$22 each, plus online ticketing fees. The Dance Concert fee is a part of monthly tuition. This fee covers the t-shirt provided for your student to wear at the Dance Concert finale as well as show production expenses.
