Columbia Air Center was the first licensed African American owned and operated airport in the United States. This airfield was located in Croom, Prince George's County, Maryland, 30 miles southeast of College Park, MD and operated from 1940–1962. During World War II, the airfield was occupied by the U.S. Navy, and the first African American Civil Air Patrol Squadron was formed here. Columbia Air Center was a shining example of Black excellence with historic connections to the Tuskegee Airmen, its members included famed saxophonist and big-band leader Jimmie Lunceford.


