MS CARES GRANT PROGRAM Eligible Expenses by Category

- 1. Costs to create social distancing measures
- 2. Costs to clean or disinfect areas including sanitizing products/cleansers
- 3. **Personal protective equipment (PPE)**: respirators, facemasks, goggles, face shields, protective eyewear, gloves, and gowns
- 4. COVID-19 testing for staff and employees as recommended by CDC guidance
- COVID-19 screenings for clients and others entering facilities or vehicles to protect grantee from exposure
- Expenses for technical assistance concerning mitigation of COVID-19 threats to public health and safety
- 7. Costs for contactless equipment used in conduct of business activities
- 8. Equipment or items designed to track employees or customers who test positive for COVID-19
- 9. Expenses incurred in quarantining individuals
- 10. Necessary re-opening expenses, specifically to address COVID issues
- 11. Expenses to facilitate teleworking to enable compliance with COVID-19 public health guidelines
- 12. **Expenses to facilitate distance learning**, including technological improvements, in connection with closings to enable compliance with COVID precautions
- 13. Expenses for additional food delivery costs and expenses, including purchase of food, to individuals/households, such as senior citizens and other vulnerable populations, to enable compliance with COVID precautions
- 14. **Expenses to care for homeless populations** provided to mitigate COVID-19 effects and enable compliance with COVID precautions
- 15. **Individual grants to prevent evictions or foreclosures** and to otherwise assist in preventing homelessness that are necessary due to the COVID-19 public health emergency
- 16. **Individual assistance to individuals and households** who have been directly impacted by a loss of income due to the COVID-19 public health emergency for necessary expenses
- 17. **Expenses for employment and training programs** for individuals who have lost employment or have been furloughed due to the COVID-19 emergency
- 18. Expenses incurred directly die to the interruption of the Applicant's business due to COVID-19, including mortgage interest, rent, payroll, or utilities
