Rules and Regulations of 2019 “Win Your Legacy” Onward Ottawa Raffle:

1. Ticket purchaser must be 18 years of age or older to participate and must have a valid Social Security number.
2. There is no limit to the number of tickets one (1) person may purchase.
3. Raffle tickets are \$125.00 each or 10 tickets for \$1,000.00. Raffle tickets may be purchased by cash, checks, money order (made payable to Onward Ottawa) or credit card. If using a check or purchasing online, the raffle tickets will be mailed to the purchaser.
4. By IRS declaration, ticket purchases for valuable prizes are not eligible for charitable tax deductions.
5. Only 1,000 tickets will be sold – odds of winning are 1:1,000.
6. Tickets may be purchased on the internet at www.ottawakansas.org or www.onwardottawa.com; or in person at the Ottawa Area Chamber of Commerce (109 E. 2nd Street, Ottawa, KS), Kansas State Bank of Ottawa (236 N. Main, Ottawa, KS), Beckman Motors (701 N. Maple, Garnett, KS), Bank Midwest of Ottawa (434 S. Main, Ottawa, KS) or Goppert State Service Bank (1250 E. Logan Drive, Ottawa, KS).
7. All tickets must be purchased with full payment before 12:00 a.m. (midnight) December 11, or before a total of 1,000 tickets have been sold, whichever comes first, to be entered in the drawing.
8. The drawing will be held Saturday, December 14, 2019 at 12:00 p.m. at Legacy Square. The grand prize of 2019 Chevrolet Silverado will be drawn first and the winning ticket sealed in an envelope. Following the grand prize drawing, additional raffle items will be drawn for and awarded to those winners. After all prizes have been awarded, the envelope with the grand prize ticket will be opened and the grand prize winner announced.
9. Winners need not be present to win. Winners will be notified by phone and certified return receipt mail within 7 days of the drawing and will be posted on Onward Ottawa’s webpage.
10. If Onward Ottawa has not sold by 5:00 pm CDT on November 29, at least 800 valid raffle tickets and received full payment thereof, Onward Ottawa may, at its sole and absolute discretion, cancel the raffle and withdraw the prizes aforementioned or decide to delay the drawing until the minimum has been purchased. In such an event, Onward Ottawa will refund in full all monies collected to all persons who made payment, if they do not want to participate in a delayed drawing or if the raffle is canceled.
11. The prize winner is solely responsible for all local, state and federal taxes, title, transfer fees, license duties, insurance and all expenses incurred in claiming the 2019 Chevrolet Silverado. The Internal Revenue Service requires that any prizes valued at \$600 or more be issued a Form W-2G and requires that 25% of total winnings be withheld for federal taxes on prizes of \$5,000 or more. The First Prize winner understands, acknowledges, and agrees that the First Prize winner is receiving a prize and will hereby release and discharge Onward Ottawa, and any additional sponsors, their employees, agents, officers, directors and legal representatives and assigns from any and all claims, liabilities, damages, losses or expenses arising from or caused by the award of such prize, including, but not limited to the payment of any and all taxes that are due. No automotive dealers are allowed to participate.
12. Prize must be claimed within 30 days of drawing. Any unclaimed prize after that date will constitute forfeiture and be transferred to Onward Ottawa as a donation.
13. Onward Ottawa, its Board of Directors, and its agents assume no liability for lost, late, misdirected, mutilated, incomplete, illegible, entries or entries without payment which will be deemed invalid and disqualified.
14. The decisions and rules of Onward Ottawa are final on all matters concerning the raffle.
15. Void where prohibited by law.

17. The gun image and specification sheet is posted on www.OnwardOttawa.com. However the picture of the gun may vary slightly from the actual gun.
18. All firearms regulations must be met before you can receive a firearm. Any winner failing to pass any relevant state or federal background check will forfeit the prize to Onward Ottawa.
19. Firearms are inherently dangerous. Winners are responsible for the safe usage and must follow all laws, regulation, and manufacturer’s instructions for safe firearm handling. Onward Ottawa and volunteers hold no liability for improper use.
