COVID-19 Vaccination Campaign

Current Vaccination Phase:

- PHASE 2 (general population) – 83% of counties
- PHASE 1c – 17% of counties

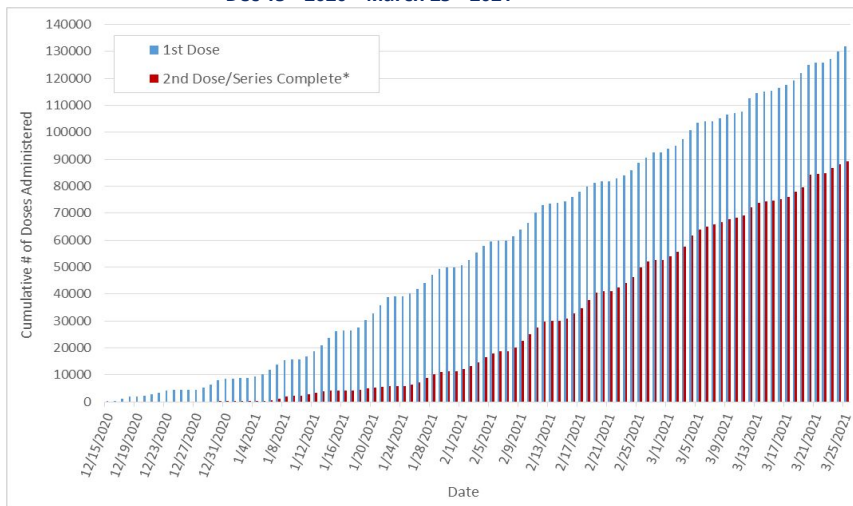
- Vaccine supply remains lower than demand, therefore, individuals named in Phase 1 may still experience delays in receiving the vaccine in some counties.
- There are now three safe and effective vaccines against COVID-19. The Janssen COVID-19 Vaccine has been approved for Emergency Use Authorization. The Janssen vaccine is one dose.

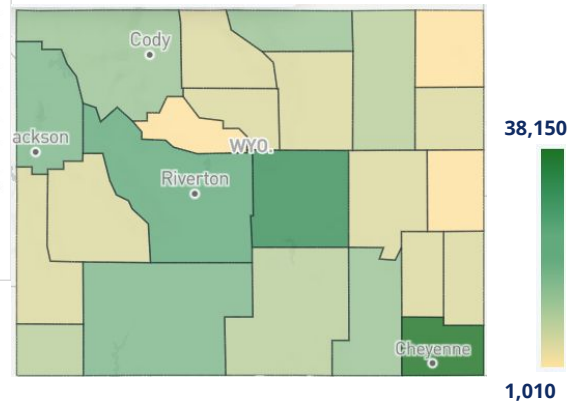
Cumulative Number of Doses Administered in Wyoming (WYIR),

Key Points & Resources

- Getting vaccinated is free. If you have insurance, your insurance can be billed for administration fees. No fees will be billed to you. If you do not have insurance, you will be able to get the vaccine and no fees will be billed to you. Vaccines are free and insurance is not required. Some people may be asked to show Medicare or insurance cards so professionals giving shots can be reimbursed.
- The CDC began the Federal Retail Pharmacy Program the week of February 8. To date, over 39,000 doses of COVID-19 vaccine have been shipped to enrolled pharmacies in Wyoming. Pharmacies have to follow Wyoming's priorities that are set at the state level for the program.
