COVID-19 Vaccination Campaign

Current Vaccination Phase:

- PHASE 1b - 87% of counties
- PHASE 1a - 13% of counties

- Since December 12th, the WDH and its partners have been distributing and administering COVID-19 vaccines as part of the continued response to the COVID-19 pandemic.
- Vaccines are being shipped to counties weekly, based on available vaccine and campaign planning efforts.
- Updates to the Wyoming Department of Health Phase 1 designations are being considered based on federal recommendations. However, vaccine supply is not significantly increasing to address potential changes that increase vaccine demand.

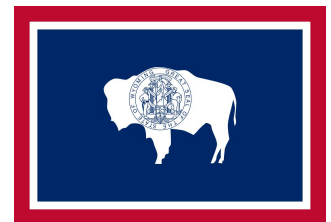
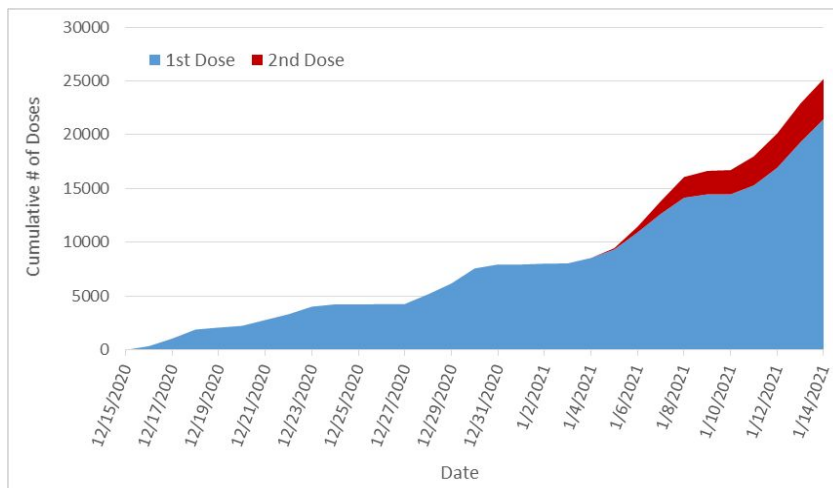

Key Points & Resources

- Vaccine supply is currently limited; county public health agencies will reach out to respective entities when sufficient vaccine is available and vaccination efforts can be expanded. The vaccine allocation to Wyoming is increasing by 200 doses for the week of January 18, 2021. Current information suggests increases in vaccine will only be 2-5% for now.
- Getting vaccinated is free; people receiving COVID-19 vaccines will not be asked to pay any fees.
- To date 23 Long-term Care Facilities (LTCF) and Assisted Living Facilities (ALF) enrolled in the Federal Pharmacy Partners LTCF Program have had vaccination clinics through Walgreens or CVS. Twenty-three facilities are scheduled to receive vaccinations through Walgreens and CVS over the next 2 weeks. Second doses will also be provided through the program.
- LTCF and ALF that did not enroll in the Federal program received vaccinations through local public health, hospitals or through facility staff.
