## Current Workgroup Projects



### Prevention Workgroup

Decrease tobacco and e-cigarette use, increase HPV vaccination completion among adolescents, and increase healthy eating and physical activity behaviors.



### Screening & Early Detection Workgroup

Increase screening rates for breast, cervical, and colorectal cancer and decrease the proportion of lung cancers diagnosed at late stage by increasing screening.



### Childhood Cancer Workgroup

Expand resources for patients and families, including palliative and end-of-life care, and provide didactic and hands-on training opportunities for healthcare providers related to childhood cancer and post-treatment survivorship needs.



### Survivorship Workgroup

Improve resources for cancer survivors and increase training and knowledge for cancer care providers related to cancer treatment and long-term care needs.

## Who can participate?

All Wyomingites can play a role in improving the lives of those affected by cancer. While the WYCC provides a statewide infrastructure, it is only through the grassroots efforts of committed partners and individuals across the state that we are able to achieve our goals. Working together and leveraging resources will help us make a greater impact throughout the state. Currently coalition membership is made up of public health agencies, community organizations, providers, health care systems, health insurers, policy makers, employers, professional organizations, and cancer survivors.

**October 2024 - July 2025**

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## WYCC Action Planning

**September 2025 - January 2026**
