COVID-19 Vaccination Campaign

- Find COVID-19 Vaccines Near You: [Vaccines.gov](https://vaccines.gov)
- As of May 20, 2021, 183,056 people have been fully vaccinated by Wyoming COVID-19 vaccine providers (those who have received 2 doses of Moderna/Pfizer or 1 dose of Janssen vaccine). Vaccination coverage data is available for each county [HERE](#).
- A map showing county level vaccination coverage data is attached.
- The FDA authorized the Pfizer vaccine for people who are 12 year of age and older on May 10 and the ACIP recommended the Pfizer vaccine for people 12 year of age and older on May 12; **1,808 first doses** were administered to 12-15 year olds as of May 24th.
- Vaccine supply levels have allowed all counties to offer vaccinations to the general public.
- Getting vaccinated is free. If you have insurance, your insurance can be billed for administration fees. No fees will be billed to you. If you do not have insurance, you will be able to get the vaccine and no fees will be billed to you.

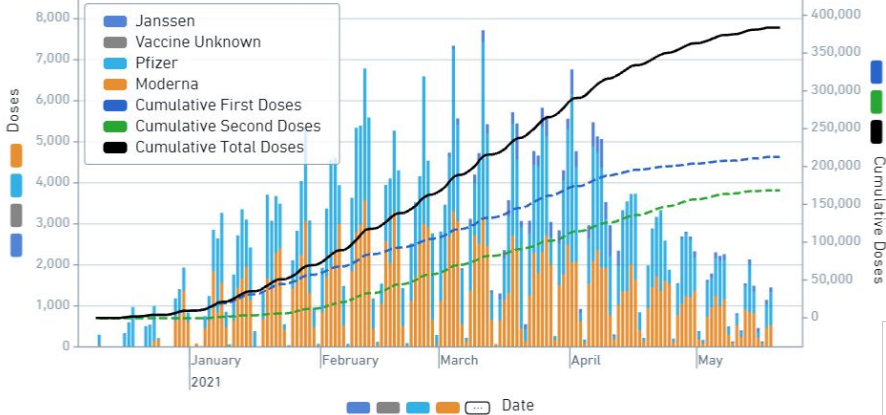

Cumulative Number of Doses Administered in Wyoming*

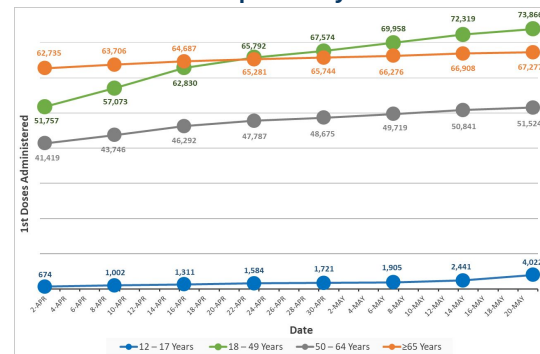
