



## **SAC Emmerson Buie, Jr. Chicago Field Office**

Emmerson Buie was appointed the Special Agent in Charge (SAC) of the FBI's Chicago Field Office in July 2019. Prior to this assignment, Mr. Buie served as the SAC of the FBI's El Paso Field Office beginning in June 2017.

Mr. Buie was promoted to the Senior Executive Service (SES) in December 2014 and assigned as the FBI Cyber Division's Senior Liaison to the Department of Homeland Security (DHS), National Cybersecurity, Communication, and Integration Center (NCCIC). In this role, he helped coordinate numerous public and private sector investigations and intelligence-sharing efforts between the FBI, DHS, and other agencies.



Prior to that assignment, SAC Buie served as the Assistant Special Agent In-Charge (ASAC) for the Springfield Field Office, and was responsible for National Security, Criminal, and Administrative matters from October 2008 to December 2014. He also served as Springfield's Leadership Development Coordinator until 2013.

SAC Buie entered on duty with the FBI in July 1992. After graduating from the FBI Academy, he was assigned to the Denver Field Office, Colorado Springs Resident Agency, where he investigated all criminal matters until November 1999, when he was promoted to a Supervisory Special Agent and assigned to the Counterterrorism Division, Weapons of Mass Destruction (WMD) Operations Unit. From 2002 to 2006, he served as the Senior Supervisory Resident Agent in the Fairview Heights, IL Resident Agency for the Springfield Field Office.

From 2006 to 2008, he served as an Assistant Legal Attaché' and Acting Deputy Legal Attaché in the U.S. Embassy in London. While in London, SAC Buie was the primary point of contact for coordinating the FBI's participation with the newly formed Five Eyes Strategic Alliance Council, Domestic Extremist Agency and Serious Organize Crime Agency (SOCA). Through his investigations and leadership, he contributed significantly to the disruption and dismantlement of organizations and arrest of individuals committing public corruption violations, white collar crime, government reservation crimes, gangs, drug trafficking, counterterrorism, cyber, counterintelligence, weapon of mass destruction, violent crimes, and civil rights laws.

SAC Buie earned a Bachelor of Arts in Operations, Productions Management from Western Illinois University, and served four years in the U.S Army as an Infantry Officer and Desert Storm Veteran. He was awarded a Bronze Star, Combat Infantry badge and multiple accommodations and awards for his military service.
