

ORDER OF THE BEXAR COUNTY LOCAL ADMINISTRATIVE JUDGE
REQUIRING THE WEARING OF FACE COVERINGS
UPON ENTERING THE COURTHOUSE COMPLEX

The Covid 19 positivity rate has increased in Bexar County for the third consecutive week. This new influx of cases is largely due to the highly transmissible Delta variant. Aside from vaccinations, the Center for Disease Control and our local health authority advise that wearing face coverings is the single most effective way to reduce the spread of the virus.

Therefore, by authority of the Texas Supreme Court's 40th Emergency Order and as described in Attorney General Opinion KP-0322, it is HEREBY ORDERED that all persons must wear face coverings when entering the Bexar County Courthouse Complex, to include the Courthouse, the Cadena Reeves Justice Center, the Paul Elizondo Tower, and all Justice of the Peace buildings, if those individuals will be involved in court business. Each individual court judge should implement this order to the best of their ability and as always consider each circumstance on a case-by-case basis. This measure is taken in an effort to reduce the spread of Covid 19 while allowing court business to continue. This order will take effect immediately.
