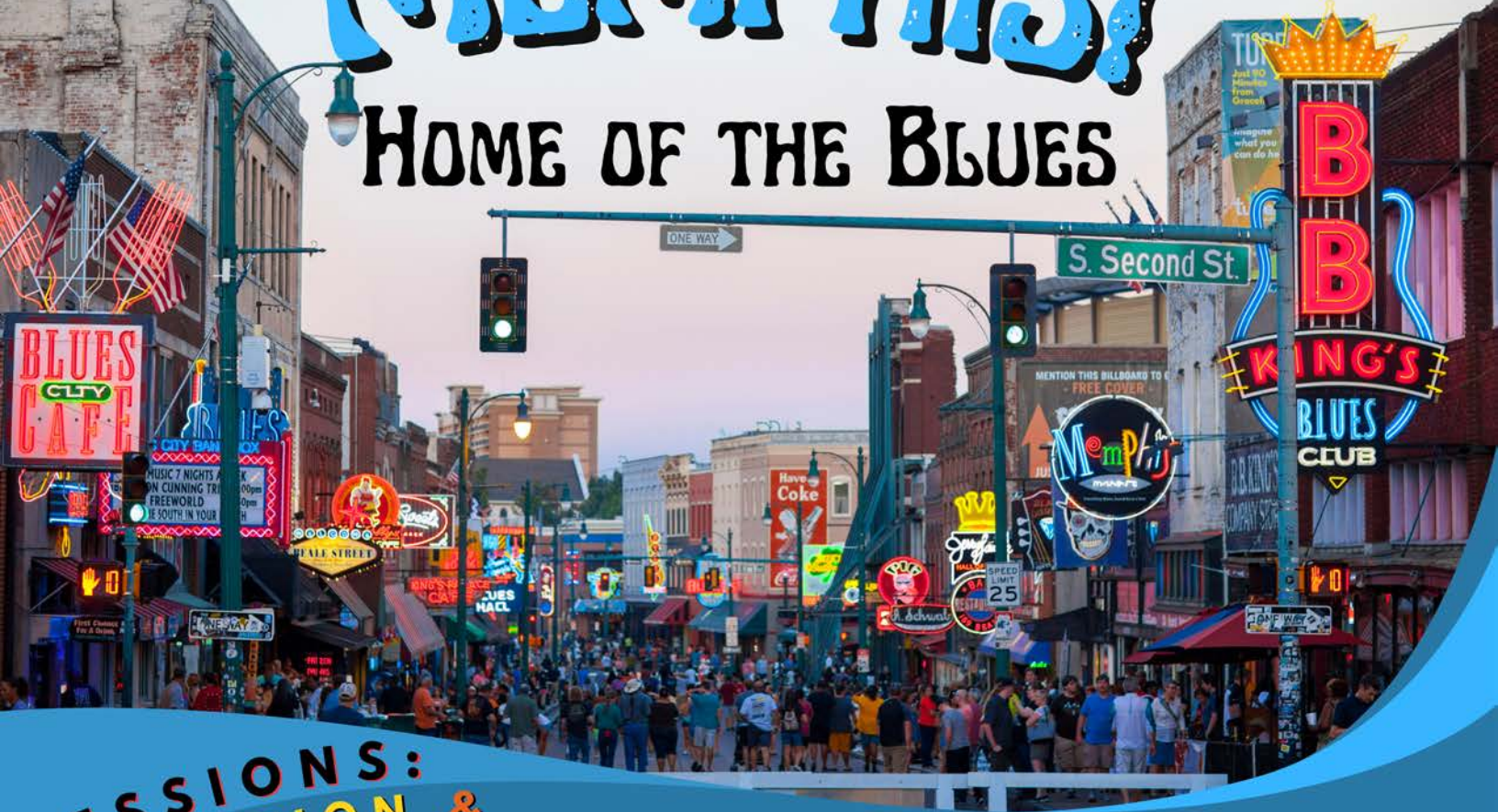

Mr. Barden's interest in the Inflation Reduction Act is derived from that Act's intersecting policy points on tax, climate change, and health issues. Ken holds a Juris Doctor from Indiana University Robert McKinney School of Law, as well as a bachelor's degree in Political Science from the University of Indianapolis. He also holds as post-graduate diplomas from the Disaster Management Centre at the University of Wisconsin and in International Humanitarian Law from the National Academy of Legal Studies and Research, in Hyderabad, India. Mr. Barden has also completed a post-graduate program in International Environment Law with the United Nations Environmental Program and the United Nations Institute for Training and Research. Mr. Barden is a Certified Anti-Money Laundering Specialist (CAMS) and a Certified Sanctions Specialist.
