Live Stakes

Live stakes should be placed 3-6 feet apart in a triangular arrangement. This helps fill spaces best. Live stakes are planted more densely than tree species normally would be, because there is an expectation that not all of the stakes will survive. One bundle of 25 will plant approximately 60 feet of stream if planted in 2 staggered rows.

Individual Species

3' live stakes available in quantities of 10 for \$30 or 25 for \$70.

Seed Mixes

These native seed mixes are designed to increase plant diversity and wildlife interest as well as stabilize soils along your stream, pond or bluff. Cover crop seeds are good for keeping disturbed soils covered. When mixed with native seed mixes they act as a nurse crop, protecting tender seedlings. 4 oz coverage amounts listed in each description. See ernstseeds.com for additional seed mix information

Site Specific Mixes

Deer Resistant Meadow Mix - 16 oz/\$48, 4 oz/\$13

Contains species that deer typically do not find palatable. It is not guaranteed that hungry deer will not eat the species in this mix, but these species are normally not preferred. 4 oz covers approximately 725 ft²

Contains: *Little Bluestem, Virginia Wildrye, Purple Coneflower, Sideoats Grama, Lanceleaf Coreopsis, Blackeyed Susan, White Beardtongue, Butterfly Milkweed, Oxeye Sunflower, Golden Alexanders, Partridge Pea, Roundhead Lespedeza, Marsh Blazing Star, Wild Senna, Blue False Indigo, Purple Lovegrass, Aromatic Aster, Brown-eyed Susan, Wild Bergamot, Gray Goldenrod, Heath Aster, Calico Aster, Hoary Mountainmint, White Goldenrod, Ohio Spiderwort, Hairy Beardtongue, Early Goldenrod.* Typical Height: 4.5 ft.

For best results mix 8 oz of common rye cover crop for every 4 oz of Deer Resistant Meadow Mix.

Riparian Buffer Mix - 16 oz/\$30, 4 oz/\$8

A diverse mix of upland and wetland grasses and forbs with extensive wildlife and pollinator value. Provides food and cover for many songbirds, pheasants, deer and turkey. 4 oz covers approximately 500 ft².

Contains: *Virginia Wildrye, Tioga Deertongue, 'Prairie View' Big Bluestem, Indiangrass, 'Habitat' Switchgrass, Blackeyed Susan, Blue Vervain, Swamp Milkweed, Golden Alexanders, Flat Topped White Aster, Wrinkleleaf Goldenrod, Lance Leaved Aster, Heath Aster, Oxeye Sunflower, Wild Bergamot, Boneset, Narrowleaf Mountainmint, Purplestem Aster* Typical Height: 6.3 ft.

For best results mix 6 oz of common rye cover crop for every 4 oz of Riparian Buffer Mix.

FACW Wetland Meadow Mix - 16 oz/\$50, 4 oz/\$13

The diverse species provide pollinator habitat and erosion control in wet meadows! 4 oz covers approximately 500 ft².

Contains: *Lurid Sedge, Virginia Wildrye, Fox Sedge, Blunt Broom Sedge, Soft Rush, Blue Vervain, Swamp Milkweed, Oxeye Sunflower, White Vervain, Golden Alexanders, Path Rush, Fowl Mannagrass American Water Horehound, Wrinkleleaf Goldenrod, Boneset, Sensitive Fern, Great Blue Lobelia, Green Bulrush, Lance Leaved Aster, Fringed Sedge, Square Stemmed Monkeyflower, Purplestem Aster, Woolgrass.* Typical Height: 5 ft.

For best results mix 6 oz of common rye cover crop for every 4 oz of FACW Wetland Meadow Mix.

Floodplain Mix - 16 oz/\$35, 4 oz/\$10

The diverse annual and perennial grasses and forbs are attractive to humans and animals. Designed for economical wildlife food and habitat in newly established wetlands where wildlife food value is needed. 4 oz covers approximately 500 ft².

Contains: *Virginia Wildrye, Tioga Deertongue, 'Prairie View' Big Bluestem, Indiangrass, Fox Sedge, Lurid Sedge, Blunt Broom Sedge, Blue Vervain, Swamp Milkweed, Soft Rush, Golden Alexanders, White Vervain, Wrinkleleaf Goldenrod, Lance Leaved Aster, New England Aster, Purplestem Aster, Boneset, Grassleaf Goldenrod, Wild Bergamot, American Water Horehound, Square Stemmed Monkeyflower, Woolgrass, Green Bulrush, Great Blue Lobelia.* Typical Height: 5 ft.

For best results mix 6 oz of common rye cover crop for every 4 oz of Floodplain Mix.

Showy Northeast Native Wildflower Mix - 16 oz/\$85, 4 oz/\$23

Contains the showiest native forbs common in the Northeast. Excellent for wildlife food and shelter, including pollinators. 4 oz covers approximately 1000 ft².

Contains: *Purple Coneflower, Lanceleaf Coreopsis, Blackeyed Susan, Oxeye Sunflower, Tall White Beardtongue, Butterfly Milkweed, Golden Alexanders, Partridge Pea, Roundhead Lespedeza, Aromatic Aster, Blue False Indigo, Wild Senna, Marsh Blazing Star, Brown-eyed Susan, Smooth Blue Aster, Slender Lespedeza, Hoary Mountainmint, Wild Bergamot, Maryland Senna, White Goldenrod, Gray Goldenrod, Heath Aster, Hairy Beardtongue, Ohio Spiderwort, Early Goldenrod.* Typical Height: 4.5 ft.

For best results mix 12 oz of common rye cover crop for every 4 oz of Showy Northeast Native Wildflower Mix.

Cover Crops

Cover Crop Mix - 16 oz/\$4, 4 oz/\$2

Annual cover crop mix. Good to cover bare ground and improve soil structure and fertility. 4 oz covers approximately 275 ft².

Contains: 75.0% Rye, Crimson Clover, Radish 'GroundHog'.

Common Rye Cover Crop - 16 oz/\$3, 4 oz/\$1.50

Bunch-type winter companion or cover crop; used for erosion control; may be planted anytime of year, but preferably in the fall or winter as rye has a strong ability to grow in cold weather. 4 oz covers approximately 350 ft².

Contains: 'Aroostook' Common Rye.
