The **"Saluting Stories of Service" celebration dinner** highlights a student and veteran interview pair, and honors an outstanding veteran or community leader with a "Storyteller's Award" for sharing stories of dedication and service to our country; making a positive impact in the community and the development of youth. The evening concludes with dancing to big band swing music. We anticipate 300 guests including VHP student alumni and families, educators, community leaders and local dignitaries, active duty military and veterans, including Medal of Honor Recipient Sammy Davis, known as the "real Forest Gump".

Program Overview

Veterans Heritage Project's after-school character education program allows middle school, high school, and community college students to become immersed in one-on-one personal accounts of heroism and service to our country, while learning leadership skills and developing a passion for history, writing and civics. At the same time, the program allows veterans to continue to serve by imparting the wisdom that can only be shared by individuals who sacrificed for the freedom of our nation.
