During the first quarter of our Kiwanis year, 36 of our Nebraska-Iowa clubs donated \$9,430 to the Kiwanis Children's Fund! Thank you! Thanks to your donations last year, our District received \$2,888 in grant funds to use to benefit our kids here in Nebraska-Iowa. The Board of Trustees will decide how those funds will be used.

A grant I would like to share with you comes from New York, where the Kiwanis Club of the Bellmores teams up with Carroll's Kitchen, a local non-profit, to provide Thanksgiving meals to families in need. This is their fourth year. The project has grown over the years with participation from churches, synagogues, food pantries and other Kiwanis Clubs to serve thousands of people. Volunteers work together to prepare and package the meals. The culinary program at a local high school prepares side dishes. Due to rising costs and food insecurity, the project's budget doubled between 2021 and 2022. A grant from the Kiwanis Children's Fund will help the Thanksgiving meals to continue and to expand. What a great project that involves the whole community working together!

I also want to share some ways your club and individual donations help. Sixty-six million children go to school hungry, and as all of you know, it's happening right here in Nebraska-Iowa.
