Milford Hanna has been a member of the Lincoln Northeast Kiwanis Club since 1975. He has served in many leadership roles at the club, division, district and international levels, including serving as the Nebraska-Iowa District governor and president of the District Foundation. He chaired the fund raising efforts in the District for the Worldwide Service Project on Eliminating Iodine Deficiency Disorders and co-chaired the same efforts on a regional basis for the Worldwide Service Project on Elimination of Maternal and Neonatal Tetanus. For over 20 years now, he has represented the District on the Kiwanis International Leadership Committee (formerly International Candidate Committee).

The Kiwanis International Leadership Committee has a representative from each Kiwanis district. It is the responsibility of the committee members to know who the candidates for International Trustee and International Offices are and to be familiar with their Kiwanis backgrounds and leadership potential. Additionally, they are supposed to be familiar with any bylaw amendments that are to be considered at the International Convention. A major responsibility is to lead the discussions of candidates and amendments at the District Caucus, which is held annually at the International Convention, and to be available during the House of Delegates session to answer questions that may arise as a result of voting procedures and results.
