

CONFIRMATION 2018

Confirmation is an important event in the life of our church. It is a time when the Covenant renews its commitment to the Christian growth and discipleship of our children. Through the vows made at baptism our church pledges to help families raise their children in the Christian faith. To do this Covenant Church has prepared a series of guided learning experiences and opportunities for confirmation. Confirmation is offered to those who are in 7th grade or older.

There are several aspects of Confirmation that will allow Covenant to offer the very best to our children.

1. Each child will be assigned an adult mentor who will develop a personal relationship with the confirmand (person seeking confirmation) and who, along with the pastors, will lead the confirmand through the experiences of confirmation. There will be a gathering for parents, confirmands and mentors Sunday January 14 at 4 p.m. in the sanctuary.
2. Confirmation Classes will be held Sunday mornings at 9:45 and 11:00 in room 204. Attendance is expected for those to be confirmed. The classes are taught by parents and other adults.
3. Each confirmand is required to attend weekly worship with their parents, and especially the first Sunday of each month to participate in the sacrament of holy communion.
4. There is a retreat planned for confirmands April 27-29 to intentionally study the basics of our faith.
5. May 5 is the Confirmation Banquet at 6:30.
6. May 6 is Confirmation Sunday. Confirmands choose to be confirmed at 8:30, 9:45 or 11:00 worship.
