REQUIREMENTS AND GUIDELINES

1. Applicant must be an active participant of Covenant Church United Methodist.
2. The application must be completed by the student alone.
3. The award committee strives to show no bias in awarding amounts to applicants. The applications will be evaluated anonymously.
4. Personal notes from applicants describing need and benefit from participating in retreats and missions are encouraged.
5. Application is due by December 20 of each year.
6. Applicants must participate in at least 2 fundraisers during the current year.
7. Parents (or family members) can work in the place of a participant when necessary.
8. Special fundraisers may be held to benefit one particular event, (for example, Senior High Summer Mission) and used to reduce the cost of the retreat or mission, which benefits all participants.
9. All funds available for distribution will be collected from January 1 through December 31. Scholarships are awarded by third Sunday of January of the following year.
10. The amount to be available for distribution will be determined by the Student-Adult Leadership Team at its first scheduled meeting for the calendar year.
11. The value of the Covenant Student Ministries Scholarship fund will vary depending on the amount available in the fund each year. An attempt will be made to make the scholarship amount equal to the need of each applicant. A financial contribution to all eligible applicants is the goal of the scholarship fund. The number of applicants will affect the amount of each award.
12. Scholarship awards apply only to youth mission trips and retreats. No awards will be made payable directly to the recipient.
13. These awards will be confidential and will not be shared publically.
