



Now we are going to have a Protect Duty how will that affect the role of licensing authorities?







All the measures will need to be proportionate but what does that mean in practice?





- What will need to be considered:
- Design and location of the premises
- What precautions are being proposed to prevent and or mitigate the effects of a terrorist attack
- What liaison is there to be with police and rescue services
- Evacuation procedures
- What internal medical provision will there be







- How will a licensing authority assess these requirements
- Expert evidence required from applicant
- Require a detailed risk assessment
- Get input from CTSA's
- Input from NHS and Ambulance Service
