



Fish stocking help needed

The Arizona Game and Fish Department's Native Trout and Chub program is stocking 250-Gila Trout in Frye Creek, and 500-Gila Trout into lower Marijilda Creek on Mount Graham, Wednesday, October 27, 2021.

The stocking of Lower Marijilda Creek will be the most physically demanding, requiring a ~4-mile hike one-way to the stream, carrying a 5 gallon bucket half-full of water and fish (~40 lbs) up Mount Graham.

The stocking of Frye Creek will be significantly easier, requiring a ~2-mile hike one way to get to the section of stream that we will stock, while carrying the same amount of weight. Both Streams will require a vehicle with high clearance and four wheel drive to reach the trailheads.

We are looking for volunteers to help us complete both of these stockings.
