- **When:** Tuesday (June 16th) to Saturday (June 20th)
- **What is a mission trip?** A mission trip is a chance to get out of our own comfort zones and be the hands and feet of Christ in the world. We seek to love our neighbors as ourselves and learn more about them. A mission trip is also an awesome group experience that will likely bond you closer than any other activity with the Jr. High youth group. Shared quarters, group meals and outings, working side by side, and early wake up calls will do that to you!
