

What Is Prop 486?

Proposition 486 is the continuation of the Road Maintenance and Improvement Fund (excise tax) in Pinal County to fund transportation.

Pinal County's road maintenance fund was originally passed in 1986 and renewed in 2005. This local funding is used to preserve and build our roads throughout our region.

This tax funds most transportation projects in our Transportation Improvement and Maintenance Program (TIMP).

The TIMP allows Pinal County residents to submit projects to the Transportation Advisory Committee, which develops the five-year transportation plan.

What Does Prop 486 Fund?

Road repair

Pothole repair

Road widening

Road preservation

New road construction

Intersection improvements

Traffic safety improvements



The reauthorization is on the **November 5, 2024**, Pinal County ballot. A "yes" vote extends the tax until 2046. A "no" vote will discontinue the tax at the end of 2026.

A 20-year continuation of the tax is projected to generate \$800 million to \$1.2 billion in revenues.

- VOTE IN PERSON ON ELECTION DAY, NOVEMBER 5.
