


BSM is an organization that provides opportunities for spiritual growth, friendship, leadership, and missions. Where students




The mission of Churches Serving Schools is to inspire and equip churches to love and support local schools in Jesus'



Texas Ramp Project is a 501(c)3 nonprofit organization which builds wheelchair ramps for disabled or elderly people who cannot afford to buy one. This work is accomplished in Smith County by a team of volunteers who offer their time, skills, and resources to provide this service. Last year this team built over 150 ramps with no charge to the recipients

In 2025, referrals by healthcare professionals for this team to build or repair ramps in Smith County have increased significantly.

The Smith County Team of Texas Ramp Project is seeking people to help with this work. Most of our volunteers are retired. Many are over age 70. Several are in their 80's. Our director has said, "If you can stand up and pull the trigger on a screw gun, we can put you to work!" You can join one of our existing teams, or start a team in your own church. Training and other resources are available.

We also need funds to build ramps. Virtually all funds you may give will be used to purchase lumber, plywood, screws, bolts, and other items essential to the construction of ramps for those in need in Smith County.
