Who can come to camp?

G.A. Summer Camp is designed for girls who have completed 1-6 grades, but you are welcome to bring girls of all ages. Some churches opt to only bring 4-6 graders while others bring girls in middle school and high school.

When is *G.A. Summer Camp* and how much does it cost?

The dates are May 29-June 2. Groups will check in between 2-3 pm on Friday afternoon. We will finish up on Tuesday morning around 10 am. The cost is \$230 per person which pays for lodging, meals, crafts, activities, and a t-shirt.

Who leads the camp worship service?

This year, our camp Pastor is Ben Bryan. He is a Pastor at County Line Baptist Church in Bullard. Our worship music will be led by our Adam McMahon (this is his 14th year leading our camp music!)

What do we do while at Camp?

There are many activities including worship time, crafts, missions, archery, GaGa ball, swimming, zip-line, canoes, and so much more.

What do I bring?

I have included a list in this packet of what you will need for the week.

What are the theme nights this year?

Each night we will have a dress-up theme. You will have a break before dinner and night worship to clean up or get into the theme of things! The themes for each night are listed below. Bring your theme attire for the following themes:

- Royal Gala
- Royal Rodeo
- Royal Spa Night
- Recycled Royalty

Remember, creativity is welcome for dressing up!

What to Bring to Camp?

- Sleeping bag or sheets to fit a twin-size bed
- Pillow
- Clothes - Please bring some you do not mind getting dirty
- Closed-toe shoes- You must wear closed-toe shoes during the day, outside the dorms, unless you are going to the pool or water slide.
- Modest Swimsuit - If your suit is too skimpy, you may be asked to wear a t-shirt over your suit.
- Swimsuit cover-up (handy for your walk to and from the pool)
- Flip-flops to wear to & from the pool, water slide or in the dorms ONLY!
- Bath towel & rag
- Toiletries (soap, shampoo, etc.)
- Toothbrush & toothpaste
- Bug repellent (*optional*)
- Money (for snacks, camp store, etc.)
- Water bottle
- Bible
- Notebook & pen
- Flashlight
- Medications currently taken
- Snacks & drinks
- Sharpie for signing camp shirts
- Clothespins for hanging swimsuits and towels on the clothesline
- Items for camp dress-up nights

Each church group will give individual instructions on bringing cell phones and other electronics. We realize many girls have cell phones. The time at camp should not be spent playing on a phone or texting. We ask kids and adults to use a paper Bible, not a Bible app on an electronic device during worship time and Bible study.

Information for Leaders

What do I need to turn in to register my group?

I have created and included a check list of all the items I will need from you.

When is the registration deadline?

Please return your church registration packet no later than April 20, 2026. This gives me time to order t-shirts, create teams, sort paperwork, and buy supplies.

How do I turn in my registration?

You can either drop your completed registration off at my church's office (Southern Oaks Baptist, 601 E. Amherst in Tyler), Smith Baptist Association Office (3226 Old Jacksonville Hwy, Tyler), or directly to me (Brandy Meadows, 2528 Canton St., Tyler, 75702).

How do I pay for camp?

Payment should be in the form of a church-issued check made payable to Smith Baptist Association that covers all people attending camp. You can submit the check at the time you submit your other paperwork or bring the check with you to camp.

What if I won't have my paperwork completed and collected by the deadline?

Call me and let me know. I will need some information from you, so I can hold space for your church group.

General Information

- Registration papers are due by April 20. This is VERY Important. I need to order t-shirts, supplies, and organize the groups.
- Each group will have a team name. You will know your team name before camp, but I cannot assign the teams until I know how many people each church is bringing. Each church will have an opportunity to decorate their side of the cabin with items related to your team's name. Bring items to decorate! We are having a decorating contest!
- Check-in at camp will be Friday, May 29, from 2-3 p.m. Leaders and girls need to come to the Tabernacle to receive their wrist bands. The wristbands must be worn all week by EVERYONE!
- Every night after the evening worship service, we will take a love offering. This offering will go to help support missions.
- Rules Regarding Medicine:
 - All prescription medicines must be:
 1. In original prescription bottle
 2. Turned in to the nurse Friday morning at registration.
 3. Dispensed by the camp nurse

Mail: You are welcome to send the GAs mail. They **LOVE** getting mail. Drop something in the mail the Monday or Tuesday before camp. All mail should be addressed as follows:

- **Counselor Requirements:** Timberline requires there to be one counselor, at least 18 years old, for every 10 girls at camp. You are welcome to bring youth leaders, but you will still need one person 18 or older for every 10 girls.
- **Emergency/Medical Release Form:** Each camper and leader must fill this out. Please use the form enclosed.
- **Criminal Background Checks:** Timberline requires that every adult (18+ years of age) counselor complete a criminal background check. Please be sure to sign the bottom of the last page! The form is enclosed. If your church does the background check, they must show proof the check was done in 2025.
- **Child Protection Training:** This must be completed every year. If you did not complete this last year, you will need to complete the training this year. The training can be found on Timberline's website (<https://www.timberlinecamp.com/child-protection-training>). There are links to the videos and the test. After watching the videos, every person should then take the test. The completed test should be submitted with your paperwork.
- **Sponsor Certification:** This form needs to be filled out and can be returned with your registration papers.
- **Certificate of Insurance:** Timberline must have a certificate of insurance from your church. This takes your church calling their insurance company and requesting them to send a certificate of insurance to Timberline Baptist Camp at Timberline's address.
