Rebecca works with 8-9 year old students. She explores economics, fractions, and everything in between. Rebecca helps students develop a love for learning that will follow them throughout their lives.

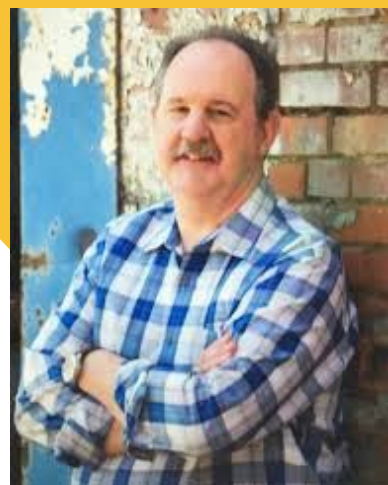
